AN ACT DECLARING THE "BALANGAY" AS THE NATIONAL BOAT OF THE PHILIPPINES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. It is the policy of the State to promote and inculcate nationalism, appreciation and pride in the cultural and historical heritage of the nation including the national symbols of the country which embody its ideals and tradition.

SEC. 2. The "Balangay" is hereby declared as the National Boat of the Philippines. It refers to the prehistoric edged pegged plank type of boat discovered and excavated in the City of Butuan.

SEC. 3. The National Historical Commission of the Philippines, in coordination with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, the National Museum, the Department of Education and other concerned agencies, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 4. Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, letter
of instruction, administrative order, rule and regulation contrary to or
inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed, modified or
amended accordingly.
SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
