AN ACT EXCLUDING FROM THE APPLICATION OF THE
INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW THOSE CONVICTED OF
CRIMINAL OFFENSES AGAINST A MINOR, AMENDING FOR
THE PURPOSE ACT NO. 4103, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE
KNOWN AS THE "INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW"

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act No. 4103, as amended, otherwise known
2 as the "Indeterminate Sentence Law", is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "SEC. 2. This Act shall not apply to persons convicted of
5 offenses punished with death penalty or life imprisonment; to those
6 convicted of treason, conspiracy or proposal to commit treason; to
7 those convicted of misprision of treason, rebellion, sedition or
8 espionage; to those convicted of piracy; TO THOSE CONVICTED OF
9 CRIMINAL OFFENSES AGAINST A MINOR, WHICH IS COMPARABLE
10 TO OR EXCEEDS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: KIDNAPPING OF A
11 MINOR, EXCEPT BY A PARENT; FALSE IMPRISONMENT OF A
12 MINOR, EXCEPT BY A PARENT, WHICH REFERS TO THE
13 DEPRIVATION OR RESTRAINT AGAINST THE WILL OF THE MINOR

1 WITHOUT LEGAL JUSTIFICATION; CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT
2 TOWARD A MINOR; SOLICITATION OF A MINOR TO ENGAGE IN
3 SEXUAL CONDUCT; USE OF A MINOR IN SEXUAL PERFORMANCE;
4 SOLICITATION OF A MINOR TO PRACTICE PROSTITUTION; ANY
5 CONDUCT THAT BY ITS NATURE IS A SEXUAL OFFENSE AGAINST A
6 MINOR; PRODUCTION OR DISTRIBUTION OF CHILD
7 PORNOGRAPHY; CHILD TRAFFICKING; AND USING CHILDREN IN
8 DRUG TRAFFICKING; to those who are habitual delinquents; to
9 those who have escaped from confinement or evaded sentence; to
10 those who having been granted conditional pardon by the Chief
11 Executive shall have violated the terms thereof; to those whose
12 maximum term of imprisonment does not exceed one (1) year, nor
13 to those already sentenced by final judgment at the time of
14 approval of this Act, except as provided in Section 5 hereof.”

15 SEC. 2. All laws, decrees, executive orders, issuances, letters of
16 instruction, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Act
17 are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

18 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
19 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
