AN ACT SEPARATING THE MAYOR BARTOLOME SERUT
NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL AND TRADE HIGH SCHOOL –
MUSIMUT ANNEX IN BARANGAY MUSIMUT, MUNICIPALITY
OF KABUGAO, PROVINCE OF APAYAO FROM THE MAYOR
BARTOLOME SERUT NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL AND
TRADE HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN
INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS
MUSIMUT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The Mayor Bartolome Serut National Agricultural and
2 Trade High School – Musimut Annex in Barangay Musimut, Municipality of
3 Kabugao, Province of Apayao is hereby separated from the Mayor Bartolome
4 Serut National Agricultural and Trade High School and converted into an
5 independent national high school to be known as Musimut National
6 High School.

1 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities, and records of the Mayor
2 Bartolome Serut National Agricultural and Trade High School – Musimut
3 Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Musimut National
4 High School.

5 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in
6 the Department's program, the operationalization of the Musimut National
7 High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current
8 year's appropriation of the Mayor Bartolome Serut National Agricultural and
9 Trade High School – Musimut Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for
10 the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General
11 Appropriations Act.

12 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and
13 regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act within one hundred
14 twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

15 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
16 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.

BARANGAY SACPIL, MUNICIPALITY OF CONNER, PROVINCE
OF APAYAO FROM THE GOVERNOR BENJAMIN LEGUIAB, SR.
MEMORIAL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO
AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN
AS SACPIL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
the Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Governor Benjamin Leguiab, Sr. Memorial
2 National High School – Sacpil Annex in Barangay Sacpil, Municipality of
3 Conner, Province of Apayao is hereby separated from the Governor Benjamin
4 Leguiab, Sr. Memorial National High School and converted into an
5 independent national high school to be known as Sacpil National High School.

6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities, and records of the
7 Governor Benjamin Leguiab, Sr. Memorial National High School – Sacpil

1 Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Sacpil National High
2 School.

3 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in
4 the Department's program, the operationalization of the Sacpil National
5 High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current
6 year's appropriation of the Governor Benjamin Leguiab, Sr. Memorial
7 National High School – Sacpil Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for
8 the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General
9 Appropriations Act.

10 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and
11 regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act within one hundred
12 twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

13 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
14 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
