- AN ACT RENUMBERING THE CEBU FIRST, SECOND AND FOURTH DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICES TO CONFORM AND CORRESPOND, RESPECTIVELY, WITH THE NUMBERING OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The current district engineering offices in the 2 Province of Cebu shall be renumbered accordingly to conform and 3 correspond, respectively, with the numbering of the three (3) 4 legislative districts of the province. Each District Engineering 5 Office shall serve the municipalities under the respective legislative 6 district.

7 SEC. 2. The Cebu First District Engineering Office, to be 8 located within the First Legislative District of the Province of Cebu, 9 shall serve the cities of Talisay, Carcar and Naga and the 10 municipalities of Minglanilla, Sibonga and San Fernando. The 11 Cebu Second District Engineering Office, to be located within the Second Legislative District of the Province of Cebu, shall serve the
 municipalities of Argao, Dalaguete, Alcoy, Boljoon, Oslob,
 Santander and Samboan. Finally, the Cebu Fourth District
 Engineering Office, to be located within the Fourth Legislative
 District of the Province of Cebu, shall serve the City of Bogo and the
 municipalities of Bantayan, Daan Bantayan, Madridejos, Medellin,
 San Remigio, Santa Fe, Tabogon and Tabuelan.

8 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall 9 issue the necessary rules and regulations to carry out the purpose of 10 this Act.

SEC. 4. Republic Act No. 9043 and Republic Act No. 9218,
 constituting the Second and First Engineering District in the
 Province of Cebu, are hereby repealed accordingly.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
circulation.
