AN ACT CHANGING THE COMPOSITION OF THE ADVISORY
COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR
CHILDREN'S TELEVISION, AMENDING FOR THE
PURPOSE SECTION 6 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8370,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "CHILDREN'S
TELEVISION ACT OF 1997"

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of Republic Act No. 8370, otherwise
2 known as the "Children's Television Act of 1997", is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "SEC. 6. *The Advisory Committee and Its*
5 *Composition.* – There is hereby constituted an Advisory
6 Committee which shall assist the Council in the
7 formulation of national policies pertaining to children's
8 broadcast programs and in monitoring its

1 implementation. The Council and the Advisory
2 Committee shall meet at least once every quarter of a
3 year.

4 "The members of the Advisory Committee shall be
5 [composed of] the following:

6 "a) the Executive Director of the Council for the
7 Welfare of Children;

8 "b) [the Chairman or Executive Director of the
9 National Commission for Culture and the Arts] THE
10 HEAD OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE
11 AND THE ARTS COMMITTEE ON CULTURAL EDUCATION
12 AND INFORMATION;

13 "c) the President of the Kapisanan ng mga
14 Brodkasters sa Pilipinas;

15 "d) the President or Executive Director of the
16 Philippine Association of National Advertisers;

17 "e) [Press Undersecretary/Officer-In-Charge of the]
18 THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE Philippine Information
19 Agency;

20 "f) the Chairman of the Movie and Television
21 Review and Classification Board; [and]

22 "g) a representative from the National
23 Telecommunications Commission[.] REGULATION
24 BRANCH; AND

25 "H) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE NATIONAL
26 YOUTH COMMISSION.

1 “Whenever any member of the Advisory
2 Committee is unable to attend, he or she shall designate
3 a representative to attend as his or her alternate.”

4 SEC. 2. All laws, presidential decrees or issuances, executive
5 orders, letters of instruction, administrative orders, rules and
6 regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this
7 Act are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

8 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
9 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
10 circulation.
