AN ACT DECLARING THE PURARAN BEACH AND ITS PREMISES LOCATED IN BARANGAY PURARAN, MUNICIPALITY OF BARAS, PROVINCE OF CATANDUANES A TOURIST SPOT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Puraran Beach and its premises located in Barangay Puraran, Municipality of Baras, Province of Catanduanes is hereby declared a tourist spot. As such, its development shall be prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT), and shall be subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of tourist destinations.

SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan involving the construction, installation and/or maintenance of such appropriate facilities which shall enhance tourism in the area:

Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation

of the natural beauty and historical significance of the area.											
		SEC. 3	. The DOT a	and its	conce	rned	attac	ched agen	cies shall		
take immediate steps to implement said tourism development plan											
	and	shall	incorporate	the	same	in	the	National	Tourism		

SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act and from internally generated funds of the DOT.

SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall issue rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
