- AN ACT ABOLISHING THE ROAD BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRIBUTION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE USER'S CHARGE COLLECTIONS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8794, ENTITLED "AN ACT IMPOSING A MOTOR VEHICLE USER'S CHARGE ON OWNERS OF ALL TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- SECTION 1. Section 7 of Republic Act No. 8794 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 7. Disposition of Monies Collected. - All monies collected under this Act shall be earmarked solely and used exclusively (1) for [road maintenance the improvement of road drainage. THE AND UPGRADING. REPAIR, CONSTRUCTION. REHABILITATION OF ROADS, BRIDGES, AND ROAD DRAINAGE; (2) [for the installation of adequate road safety traffic lights and and efficient CONTROL. INCLUDING devices. POLLUTION ESTABLISHMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES; and (3) [for air pollution control VEHICLE POLLUTION CONTROL.

"[All such monies collected shall be deposited in four (4) special trust accounts in the National Treasury, namely: (1) Special Road Support Fund; (2) Special Local Road Fund; (3) Special Road Safety Fund; and (4) Special Vehicle Pollution Control Fund.]

"ALL SUCH MONIES COLLECTED SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN FOUR (4) SPECIAL TRUST ACCOUNTS IN THE NATIONAL TREASURY, NAMELY: (1) SPECIAL NATIONAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND; (2) SPECIAL LOCAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND; (3) SPECIAL POLLUTION CONTROL FUND; AND (4) SPECIAL VEHICLE POLLUTION CONTROL FUND.

"The distribution of collections under this Act shall be as follows:

1	"(1) [Eighty percent (80%)] FORTY PERCENT
2	(40%) shall be allotted to and placed in the [Special
3	Road Support Fund] SPECIAL NATIONAL ROAD
4	SUPPORT FUND;
5	"(2) [Five percent (5%)] FORTY PERCENT (40%)
6	shall be allotted to and placed in the [Special Local
7	Road Fund] SPECIAL LOCAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND;
8	"(3) [Seven and one-half percent (7.5%)] TEN
9	PERCENT (10%) shall be allotted to and placed in the
10	[Special Road Safety Fund] SPECIAL POLLUTION
11	CONTROL FUND; and
12	"(4) [Seven and one-half percent (7.5%)] TEN
13	PERCENT (10%) shall be allotted to and placeD in the
14	Special Vehicle Pollution Control Fund.
15	"[The Special Road Support Fund, the Special
16	Local Road Fund and the Special Road Safety Fund
17	shall be under the DPWH, whereas the Special Vehicle
18	Pollution Control Fund shall be under the DOTC.]
19	"THE SPECIAL NATIONAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND
20	AND THE SPECIAL LOCAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND SHALL
21	BE UNDER THE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF THE
22	DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS
23	(DPWH); THE SPECIAL POLLUTION CONTROL FUND
24	SHALL BE UNDER THE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF
25	THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL

RESOURCES (DENR); AND THE SPECIAL VEHICLE

4 POLLUTION CONTROL FUND SHALL BE UNDER THE 1 MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF 2 TRANSPORTATION (DOTR). 3 "[Seventy percent (70%) of the Special Road 4 Support Fund shall be used exclusively for the 5 maintenance of, and the improvement of drainage of, 6 national primary roads. The remaining thirty percent 7 (30%) thereof shall be allocated and used for the 8 maintenance, and improvement of drainage of national 9 secondary roads throughout the country. 10 "The cost of installation of adequate and efficient 11 traffic lights and road safety devices throughout the 12 country, where such traffic lights and safety devices are 13 needed, shall be taken from the Special Road Safety 14 Fund. 15 "THE SPECIAL NATIONAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND 16 SHALL BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, UPGRADING, 17 REPAIR, AND REHABILITATION OF NATIONAL ROADS, 18 BRIDGES, AND ROAD DRAINAGE. 19 Special Local Road Fund shall be "The 20 apportioned to provincial and city governments in 21 accordance with the vehicle population and size of the 22 road network under their respective jurisdictions, and 23 shall be used exclusively for maintenance of local roads, 24

> "THE SPECIAL LOCAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND SHALL BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, UPGRADING,

"[A Road Board to implement the prudent and 1 efficient management and utilization of the special 2 funds shall be organized by the President of the 3 The Road Board shall be composed of 4 Philippines. seven (7) members, with the Secretary of the DPWH as 5 ex officio head, and the secretaries of the Departments 6 7 of Finance. Budget and Management, and Transportation and Communications, as ex officio 8 members. The remaining three (3) members shall come 9 from transport and motorist organizations which have 10 been in existence and active for the last five (5) years 11 prior to this Act. They shall be appointed for a term of 12 two (2) years each by the President of the Philippines 13 upon the recommendation of the secretaries of the 14 DPWH and the DOTC.]" 15

SEC. 2. Section 8 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

"[SEC. 8. Status of the Special Funds. — The four (4) special funds established under this Act shall be distinct and separate from and in addition to any appropriation authorized and granted yearly to the DPWH and the DOTC to cover expenditures for the identified objects of expenditures under this Act. Congress shall continue to appropriate an amount in the General Appropriations Act for road maintenance of the DPWH: Provided, however, That any savings for each year out of such appropriation shall revert to the

General Fund. Any savings from the special funds created herein shall accrue to these respective special funds.

"SEC. 8. STATUS OF THE SPECIAL FUNDS. THE FOUR (4) SPECIAL FUNDS ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE DISTINCT AND SEPARATE FROM AND IN ADDITION TO ANY APPROPRIATION AUTHORIZED AND GRANTED YEARLY TO THE DPWH, THE DOTR, AND THE DENR TO COVER EXPENDITURES FOR THE IDENTIFIED OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURES UNDER THIS ACT. CONGRESS SHALL CONTINUE TO APPROPRIATE AN AMOUNT IN THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE OF THE DPWH: PROVIDED. HOWEVER, THAT ANY SAVINGS FOR EACH YEAR OUT OF SUCH APPROPRIATION SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND. ANY SAVINGS FROM THE SPECIAL FUNDS CREATED HEREIN SHALL ACCRUE TO THESE RESPECTIVE SPECIAL FUNDS: PROVIDED, FURTHER. THAT ALL SUCH MONIES REMAINING UNDER THE SPECIAL NATIONAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND, AND SPECIAL LOCAL ROAD SUPPORT FUND SHALL REMAIN UNDER THE EXISTING TRUST ACCOUNTS AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE DPWH: PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, THAT ALL SUCH MONIES REMAINING UNDER THE SPECIAL ROAD SAFETY FUND SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO A SPECIAL TRUST ACCOUNT, NAMELY: SPECIAL POLLUTION CONTROL FUND AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE DENR: PROVIDED, FINALLY, THAT ALL SUCH MONIES

1	REMAINING UNDER THE SPECIAL VEHICLE POLLUTION
2	CONTROL FUND SHALL REMAIN IN THE SAME TRUST
3	ACCOUNT AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE DOTR."
4	SEC. 3. Section 9 of the same Act is hereby amended to read
5	as follows:
6	"Sec. 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations
7	The secretaries of the DPWH, THE DOTR, and the
8	[DOTC] DENR shall jointly, within thirty (30) days
9	from the effectivity of this Act, AND ANY AMENDMENTS
10	THERETO, promulgate the rules and regulations to
11	implement and carry out the intent, objectives,
12	purposes, and provisions of this Act, AS AMENDED,
13	including such structural and procedural improvements
14	in the systems and agencies concerned as may be
15	necessary to ensure the prudent, wise, effective, and
16	efficient utilization of the special funds established
17	under this Act, AS AMENDED: Provided, That the
18	Secretary of the DPWH shall prepare the portion of the
19	implementing rules and regulations pertaining to the
20	Special NATIONAL Road Support Fund[,] AND the
21	Special Local Road SUPPORT Fund[,]; [and the Special
22	Road Safety Fund, and the Secretary of the [DOTC]
23	DOTR shall prepare the portion of the implementing
24	rules and regulations pertaining to the collection of the
25	MVUC stated under Section 3 of this Act and on the
26	disposition of the monies accruing to the Special Vehicle

1	Pollution Control Fund.] [AND] THE SECRETARY OF
2	THE DOTR SHALL PREPARE THE PORTION OF THE
3	IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING
4	TO THE SPECIAL VEHICLE POLLUTION CONTROL FUND
5	AND COLLECTION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE USER'S
6	CHARGE (MVUC); AND THE SECRETARY OF THE
7	DENR SHALL PREPARE THE PORTION OF THE
8	IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING
9	TO THE SPECIAL POLLUTION CONTROL FUND."
10	SEC. 4. Abolition of the Road Board The Road Board
11	created by Republic Act No. 8794 is hereby abolished.
12	SEC. 5. Absorption of Affected Personnel, Separation and
13	Retirement Benefits The Department of Public Works and
14	Highways (DPWH) shall, as needed, absorb the employees of the
15	secretariat of the abolished Road Board, without diminution of their
16	salaries and other benefits. Employees who are separated from the
17	service as a result of the abolition of the Road Board and its
18	secretariat shall receive separation benefits under the provisions of
19	Republic Act No. 6656: Provided, That those who are qualified to
20	retire under existing laws shall be allowed to retire and receive
21	retirement benefits to which they may be entitled to under
22	applicable laws, rules and regulations.
23	SEC. 6. Transfer of Rights, Assets, and Liabilities The
24	DPWH shall, by virtue of this Act, be subrogated to all the rights
25	and assume all the obligations and liabilities of the Road Board, and
26	all records, property, assets, equipment, and funds of the Road

- Board, including unexpended appropriations or allocations, shall be transferred to the DPWH.
- 3 SEC. 7. Congressional Oversight Committee. - There is 4 hereby created a Congressional Oversight Committee to monitor the 5 implementation of Republic Act No. 8794, as amended, and the use of the special funds established therein. The Committee shall be 6 7 composed of five (5) Members of the House of Representatives and 8 five (5) Senators to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of 9 Representatives and the President of the Senate, respectively: 10 Provided. That one (1) Member of the House of Representatives and one (1) Senator shall come from the minority of each House of 11 12 Congress. The Committee shall be jointly chaired by a Member of the House of Representatives and a Senator designated by the 13 Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the 14 15 Senate, respectively.
 - SEC. 8. Separability Clause. If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining parts or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
 - SEC. 9. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances, or parts thereof, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
 - SEC. 10. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
