AN ACT CREATING FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL BRANCHES OF THE REGIONAL TRIAL COURT IN NATIONAL CAPITAL JUDICIAL REGION TO RE STATIONED IN THE CITY OF CALOOCAN, AND APPROPRIATING **FUNDS** THEREFOR. AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 14(D) OF BATAS BLG. 129. PAMBANSA OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980". AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Four (4) additional branches of the Regional
Trial Court to be stationed in the City of Caloocan, Metro
Manila, are hereby created in the Fourth Judicial Region,
with seats at Caloocan City North.

The Supreme Court shall assign the respective branch numbers for the newly created branches of the Regional Trial Court.

SEC. 2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with the Secretary of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the Court's program the

1	operationalization of the four (4) additional branches of the
2	Regional Trial Court to be stationed in the City of Caloocan,
3	Metro Manila, the funding of which shall be included in the
4	annual General Appropriations Act.
5	SEC. 3. Section 14(d) of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise
6	known as "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended,
7	and all other laws, rules and regulations which are inconsistent
8	with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.
9	SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
10	its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in any
11	newspaper of general circulation.
