ANOTHER PERIOD TO FILE AN ACT GRANTING INTENTION VALIDATE MANIFESTATION OF TO TITLES ISSUED UNDER CIVIL RESERVATION CASE NO. 1, GLRO RECORD NO. 211, PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 931, AS AMENDED, AND AS PROVIDED UNDER PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1271, AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Validation Period. All holders of titles issued on or before July 31, 1973, under Civil Reservation Case No. 1, GLRO, Record No. 211, pursuant to Republic Act No. 931, as amended, are hereby given another period of two (2) years to avail of the benefit of validation.

 SEC. 2. Conditions. Applications for validation shall

 SEC. 2. Conditions. Applications for validation shall comply with the conditions and other requirements set forth by Sections 1 and 2 of Presidential Decree No. 1271: Provided, That holders of validated titles shall pay the amount equivalent to twenty percent (20%) of the assessed value of the land.

SEC. 3. Publication The City Treasurer and City Assessor
of Baguio City, the Register of Deeds, Baguio City, and the Land
Management Bureau of the Department of Environment and
Natural Resources (DENR) are hereby directed to cause the
necessary publication and personal notice to holders of such
titles and to include therein the effect of failure to avail of the
validation process pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of Presidential
Decree No. 1271.

- SEC. 4. Implementing Rules and Regulations. Within three (3) months after the effectivity of this Act, the DENR, in coordination with the Land Registration Authority (LRA) and the City Government of Baguio, shall issue the necessary implementing rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 5. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is declared invalid, the remainder of this Act or any provision not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
- SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. All laws, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.
- SEC. 7. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
