AN ACT DECLARING KENNON ROAD TRAVERSING BAGUIO CITY AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUBA, PROVINCE OF BENGUET AS A NATIONAL HERITAGE ZONE, PROVIDING FOR ITS CONSERVATION, RESTORATION, REHABILITATION AND DEVELOPMENT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. It is the policy of the State to protect, preserve and conserve the nation's cultural heritage, its properties and history, and the ethnicities of local

- 5 SEC. 2. Declaration as National Heritage Zone. The
- 6 Kennon Road, traversing Barangays BGH, Military Cut-off,
- 7 Camp 8, San Vicente, Poliwes, and Camp 7 in Baguio City and
- 8 Barangays Camp 6, Camp 5, Camp 4, Camp 3, Camp 2, and Camp 1
- 9 in the Municipality of Tuba, Province of Benguet, is hereby declared
- 10 a National Heritage Zone.

The Kennon Road shall be accorded priority development by the Department of Tourism (DOT) and other concerned departments and agencies of the government, subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of national heritage zones.

SEC. 3. Development Plan. — Within one (1) year after the effectivity of this Act, the DOT, in partnership with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA), the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the City Government of Baguio, the Municipal Government of Tuba, and other government agencies concerned, shall prepare the development plan for the conservation, restoration, rehabilitation and development of the area where Kennon Road is situated: Provided, That such development plan shall ensure the preservation of cultural heritage and historical sites identified to be located in the area of development.

SEC. 4. Coordination Among National Government Agencies and Local Government Units. — The DOT, together with the TIEZA and the DPWH, in coordination with the City Government of Baguio and the Municipal Government of Tuba, shall prepare the infrastructure program and implement the necessary construction and improvement of Kennon Road and other related infrastructure projects.

SEC. 5. Appropriations. – The Secretary of Tourism and the Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall immediately include in their respective programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General

3	SEC. 6. Implementing Rules and Regulations Within
4	ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary of the
5	DOT and the Secretary of the DPWH, in consultation with
6	concerned stakeholders, shall formulate the rules and regulations
7	implementing the provisions of this Act.
8	SEC. 7. Separability Clause If any provision of this Act is
9	held invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not so declared
10	shall remain in force and effect.
11	SEC. 8. Repealing Clause All laws, decrees, orders and
12	rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions
13	of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
14	SEC. 9. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
15	days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of
16	general circulation.
