AN ACT ESTABLISHING MULTISPECIES MARINE HATCHERIES IN THE CITY OF ZAMBOANGA AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources of the Department of Agriculture (BFAR-DA), multispecies marine hatcheries in the City of Zamboanga.

SEC. 2. The BFAR-DA shall, within three (3) years after the establishment of the multispecies marine hatcheries, transfer the management of the same to the local government of the City of Zamboanga through a memorandum of agreement. The BFAR-DA shall implement a training and phasing-in program for local government personnel on the management and operation of the multispecies marine hatcheries.

The BFAR-DA shall conduct continuing research and experimentation on the breeding and production of marine species,

SEC. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the establishment of the multispecies marine hatcheries in the City of Zamboanga, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The local government units concerned shall set aside funds from any available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the multispecies marine hatcheries.

SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, monitoring, and the transfer of the management of the multispecies marine hatcheries to the City of Zamboanga.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
