- AN ACT EXPANDING THE PROHIBITION OF DISCRIMINATORY ACTS AGAINST WOMEN ON ACCOUNT OF SEX, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Article 133 of the Labor Code of the Philippines is
 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "ART. 133. Discrimination Prohibited. - It shall
4 be unlawful for any employer to discriminate against
5 any woman employee with respect to terms and
6 conditions of employment solely on account of her sex.
7 "The following are acts of discrimination:

8 "(a) Payment of a lesser compensation, including
9 wage, salary or other form of remuneration and fringe

benefits[,] to a female employee as against a male employee for work of equal value; [and]

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"(b) Favoring a male employee over a female employee with respect to promotion, ASSIGNMENT, training opportunities, study and scholarship grants solely on account of their sex[es.]; AND

7 "(C) FAVORING A MALE EMPLOYEE OVER A
8 FEMALE EMPLOYEE WITH RESPECT TO DISMISSAL OF
9 PERSONNEL OR THE APPLICATION OF ANY
10 RETRENCHMENT POLICY OF THE EMPLOYER SOLELY ON
11 ACCOUNT OF THEIR SEX."

"[Criminal liability for the willful commission of 12 any unlawful act as provided in this Article or any 13 violation of the rules and regulations issued pursuant to 14 Section 2 hereof shall be penalized as provided in 15 Articles 288 and 289 of this Code: Provided. That the 16 institution of any criminal action under this provision 17 shall not bar the aggrieved employee from filing an 18 entirely separate and distinct action for money claims, 19 which may include claims for damages and other 20 affirmative reliefs. The actions hereby authorized shall 21 proceed independently of each other.]" 22

23 SEC. 2. Article 135 of Labor Code of the Philippines is hereby
 24 amended to read as follows:

25 "ART. 135. Prohibited Acts. - It shall be unlawful
26 for any employer:

27 "(1) To deny any woman employee the benefits
28 provided for in this Chapter or to discharge any woman

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1	[employed by him] EMPLOYEE for the purpose of
2	preventing her from enjoying any of the benefits
3	provided under this Code;
4	"(2) To discharge such woman on account of her
5	pregnancy[,] or while on leave or in confinement due to
6	her pregnancy;
7	"(3) To discharge or refuse the admission of such
8	woman upon returning to her work for fear that she
9	may again be pregnant[.];
10	"(4) TO DENY ANY WOMAN THE EMPLOYMENT
11	BENEFITS PROVIDED UNDER OUR LAWS BY REASON OF
12	HER SEX."
13	SEC. 3. A new article denominated as Article 135-A is hereby
14	added after Article 135 to read as follows:
15	"ART. 135-A. PENALTIES ANY EMPLOYER WHO
16	COMMITS ANY OF THE ACTS PROHIBITED IN ARTICLES
17	133 AND 135 SHALL, IN ADDITION TO OTHER PENALTIES
18	AS MAY BE PROVIDED BY LAW, UPON CONVICTION, BE
19	PUNISHED WITH A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN FIFTY
20	THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) NOR MORE THAN TWO
21	HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P200,000.00) OR
22	IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) MONTHS
23	NOR MORE THAN THREE (3) YEARS OR BOTH SUCH FINE
24	AND IMPRISONMENT AT THE DISCRETION OF THE
25	COURT: PROVIDED, THAT THE INSTITUTION OF ANY
26	CRIMINAL ACTION SHALL NOT BAR THE AGGRIEVED
27	EMPLOYEE FROM FILING AN ENTIRELY SEPARATE AND
28	DISTINCT ACTION FOR MONEY CLAIMS WHICH MAY
29	INCLUDE CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES AND OTHER

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AFFIRMATIVE RELIEFS. THE ACTIONS HEREIN AUTHORIZED SHALL PROCEED INDEPENDENTLY OF EACH OTHER.

"IN ADDITION TO SUCH PENALTY, ANY ALIEN FOUND GUILTY SHALL BE SUMMARILY DEPORTED UPON COMPLETION OF SERVICE OF SENTENCE.

7 "ANY EMPLOYEE OR PERSON WHO WILLFULLY
8 AIDS OR ABETS IN THE COMMISSION OF THE ACTS
9 PROHIBITED IN ARTICLES 133 AND 135 OR WHO CAUSES
10 THE COMMISSION OF ANY SUCH ACTS BY ANOTHER
11 SHALL BE LIABLE IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE
12 EMPLOYER.

"IF THE OFFENSE 13 IS COMMITTED BY A 14 CORPORATION, TRUST. FIRM, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR ANY OTHER ENTITY, THE PENALTY 15 SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON THE GUILTY OFFICER OR 16 OFFICERS OF SUCH CORPORATION, TRUST, FIRM, 17 PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR ENTITY." 18

SEC. 4. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

23 SEC. 5. *Effectivity*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
24 days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper
25 of general circulation.
