- AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP) IN CALOOCAN CITY-NORTH, TO BE KNOWN AS THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (PUP)-CALOOCAN CITY-NORTH CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP-Caloocan
 City-North Campus Act".

3 SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the
4 Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) in Caloocan
5 City-North to be known as the PUP-Caloocan City-North Campus.

6 SEC. 3. The PUP shall admit students to its Caloocan 7 City-North Campus who may avail of graduate, undergraduate and 8 short-term technical-vocational courses within the University's 9 areas of specialization, in pursuit of its mandate, and according to 10 its capabilities as the Board of Regents may deem necessary to 11 respond to the needs of the city and the National Capital Region.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 The PUP is also mandated to undertake research and 2 extension services in the Caloocan City-North Campus, and to 3 provide progressive leadership in these areas, including the offering 4 of graduate degrees under the PUP Open University System.

5 SEC. 4. The PUP-Caloocan City-North Campus shall be 6 headed by a Campus Administrator who shall render full-time 7 service and shall be appointed or designated by the Board of 8 Regents upon the recommendation of the search committee and the 9 President, subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards set 10 by the Board of Regents.

SEC. 5. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of
 this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is
declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or
provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules
and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of
this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
circulation.
