AN ACT DECLARING THE ISLAND OF BALANGINGI IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PIO V. CORPUZ, PROVINCE OF MASBATE AN ECOTOURISM SITE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote a sustainable and effective ecotourism industry to attract tourists, both local and foreign. Towards this end, the country shall reconcile all efforts pertaining to environmental protection with those relating to the development of the tourism industry as a major source of livelihood and an avenue for the generation of employment. Aggressive measures shall be taken to restore the country's preeminence in the Asian tourist market: *Provided*, That such measures shall be consistent with the primordial obligation of preserving the existing ecosystem and natural environment.

SEC. 2. The Island of Balangingi in the Municipality of Pio V. Corpuz, Province of Masbate is hereby declared an ecotourism site.

SEC. 3. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, there shall be created an ecotourism board, to be known as the Balangingi Ecotourism Governing Board.

The Governing Board shall be composed of the following:

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- (a) The Representative of the Third Congressional District of Masbate, as Chairperson;
- (b) The Secretary of the Department of Tourism (DOT) or a duly authorized representative, as member;
 - (c) The Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) or a duly authorized representative, as member:
- (d) The Mayor of the Municipality of Pio V. Corpuz, asmember; and
 - (e) Three (3) members, to be appointed by the local legislative body, from the following sectors: (1) accredited nongovernment organization advocating the preservation of the environment; (2) the academe; and (3) the business sector. They shall serve for a term of five (5) years, and their appointment may be renewed for another term.

Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Governing Board shall promulgate the appropriate rules and regulations necessary for the implementation of the provisions of this Act. It shall, whenever necessary, amend, modify or revise such rules and regulations to meet existing needs.

SEC. 4. The provincial government of Masbate shall provide a Secretariat for the Governing Board, including the necessary expenses for the performance of its official functions and activities.

SEC. 5. Within four (4) months from the approval of this Act, the DOT and the DENR shall develop a master plan to be approved by the President of the Republic of the Philippines upon the recommendation of the Governing Board.

SEC. 6. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act and from internally generated funds of the DOT.

SEC. 7. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 8. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 9 This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
