Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

The Supreme Court shall assign the branch number for newly created branch of the Regional Trial Court.

- SEC. 2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with the Secretary of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the Court's program the operationalization of the additional branch of the Regional Trial Court to be stationed in the Municipality of Larena, Province of Siquijor, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 3. Section 14(h) of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise known as "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended, and all other laws, rules and regulations that are inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
