AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE ACADEMY (PNPA) AND THE NATIONAL POLICE TRAINING INSTITUTE (NPTI) FROM THE PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SAFETY COLLEGE (PPSC) TO THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP), AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTIONS 24, 35, 66 AND 67 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6975, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT OF 1990", AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 24 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

1	"SEC. 24. Powers and Functions The PNP
2	shall have the following powers and functions:
3	"x x x
4	"In addition, the PNP shall absorb the office of the
5	National Action Committee on Anti-Hijacking (NACAH)
6	of the Department of National Defense, all the functions
7	of the present Philippine Air Force Security Command
8	(PAFSECOM), as well as the police functions of the
9	Coast Guard. In order to perform its powers and
10	functions efficiently and effectively, the PNP shall be
11	provided with adequate land, sea, and air capabilities
12	and all necessary material means or resources.
13	"TO BETTER ACHIEVE THE GOALS OF A HIGHLY
14	EFFICIENT AND COMPETENT POLICE FORCE, THE
15	PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) SHALL HAVE
16	ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL SUPERVISION AND
17	CONTROL OVER THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE
18	ACADEMY (PNPA) ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO
19	SECTION 13 OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE No. 1184, AND
20	THE NATIONAL POLICE TRAINING INSTITUTE (NPTI),
21	FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL
22	TRAINING CENTER (PNTC)."
23	SEC. 2. A new Section 35-A is hereby inserted in the same
24	Act, to read as follows:
25	"Sec. 35-A. PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE
26	ACADEMY (PNPA) AND NATIONAL POLICE TRAINING
27	INSTITUTE (NPTI) THE PNPA IS THE PREMIER
28	INSTITUTION FOR POLICE EDUCATION, AND THE

1	PRIMARY SOURCE FOR COMMISSIONSHIP OF POLICE
2	INSPECTORS. THE PNPA SHALL BE UNDER THE
3	DIRECT ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL
4	SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE CHIEF OF
5	THE PNP.
6	"THE PNPA SHALL BE HEADED BY A PNPA
7	DIRECTOR WITH THE RANK OF POLICE DIRECTOR, WHO
8	SHALL BE ASSISTED BY A DEPUTY DIRECTOR WITH THE
9	RANK OF CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT. THE PNPA SHALL
10	HAVE A DEAN OF ACADEMICS AND A COMMANDANT,
11	BOTH WITH THE RANK OF CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT.
12	"THE NPTI SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
13	MANDATORY AND LEADERSHIP TRAININGS OF ALL
14	POLICE NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICERS (PNCOs).
15	THE SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OVER THE NPTI
16	SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN THE REVISED
17	ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN
18	UNDER SECTION 68-B.
19	"THE NPTI SHALL BE HEADED BY A DIRECTOR
20	WITH THE RANK OF POLICE DIRECTOR."
21	SEC. 3. Section 66 of the same Act is hereby amended to read
22	as follows:
23	"SEC. 66. Creation of the Philippine Public Safety
24	College There is hereby created the Philippine
25	Public Safety College (PPSC), which shall be the
26	premier educational institution for the training, human
27	resource development and continuing education of all
28	personnel of the [PNP,]BUREAU OF Fire PROTECTION

1	and BUREAU OF Jail MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY
2	[Bureaus] AND THE PROVIDER OF SELECT CAREER
3	COURSES FOR POLICE COMMISSIONED OFFICERS AND
4	SPECIALIZED COURSES FOR PERSONNEL OF THE PNP.
5	"[Said]THE College shall be under the direct
6	supervision of a Board of Trustees composed of the
7	Secretary and the three (3) bureau heads."
8	SEC. 4. Section 67 of the same Act is hereby amended to read
9	as follows:
10	"Sec. 67. Composition, Powers and Functions
11	The College shall consist of [the present Philippine
12	National Police Academy (PNPA) established pursuant
13	to Section 13 of Presidential Decree No. 1184,] the
14	NATIONAL Fire [Service] Training [Center] INSTITUTE,
15	[the Philippine National Training Center (PNTC),] the
16	National Police College, THE NATIONAL FORENSIC
17	SCIENCE TRAINING INSTITUTE, THE NATIONAL JAIL
18	MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY TRAINING INSTITUTE,
19	and other special training centers as may be created by
20	the Department, whose functions shall be as follows:
21	"(a) Formulate and implement training programs
22	for [the personnel of the] SELECT COMMISSIONED
23	OFFICERS OF THE PNP WHO SHALL UNDERGO HIGHER
24	EDUCATION AT THE NATIONAL POLICE COLLEGE, ALL
25	BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION AND BUREAU OF JAIL
26	MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY PERSONNEL, AND THE

1	PERSONNEL OF OTHER BUREAUS UNDER THE
2	Department;
3	"(b) Establish and maintain adequate physical
4	training facilities;
5	"(c) Develop and implement research and
6	development to support educational training programs;
7	"(d) Conduct an assessment of the training needs
8	of all its clientele; and
9	"(e) Perform such other related functions as may
10	be prescribed by the Secretary."
11	SEC. 5. A new Section 68-A is hereby inserted to read as
12	follows:
13	"Sec. 68-A. Transfer of Personnel and
14	PROPERTIES THE PERSONNEL AND ALL THE
15	PROPERTIES, FACILITIES, RECORDS, EQUIPMENT,
16	FUNDS, CHOSES IN ACTION, APPROPRIATIONS, RIGHTS,
17	FUNCTIONS, LIABILITIES AND OTHER ASSETS OF THE
18	PNPA AND NPTI ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED TO THE
19	PNP."
20	SEC. 6. A new Section 68-B is hereby inserted to read as
21	follows:
22	"Sec. 68-B. Transition (a) Within one
23	HUNDRED TWENTY (120) DAYS FROM THE EFFECTIVITY
24	OF THIS ACT, THE CHIEF OF THE PNP SHALL SUBMIT
25	THE REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND
26	STAFFING PATTERN OF THE PNPA AND THE NPTI TO
27	THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION (NAPOLCOM)
28	AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT

(DBM) FOR APPROVAL. THE REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN MAY INCLUDE THE REORGANIZATION AND RENAMING OF EXISTING PNP TRAINING OFFICES AND UNITS, AND THE REALIGNMENT OF FUNCTIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY.

- "(B) THE PERSONNEL OF THE PNPA AND THE NPTI SHALL BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE PPSC TO THE PNP AND CONTINUE TO PERFORM THEIR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND RECEIVE THEIR CORRESPONDING SALARIES AND BENEFITS.
- "(C) THE PNP, PPSC, PNPA, AND NPTI SHALL JOINTLY CONDUCT AN INVENTORY OF ALL THE PROPERTIES, FACILITIES, RECORDS, EQUIPMENT, FUNDS, CHOSES IN ACTION, APPROPRIATIONS, RIGHTS, FUNCTIONS, LIABILITIES AND OTHER ASSETS OF THE PNPA AND NPTI PRIOR TO THEIR COMPLETE TRANSFER TO THE PNP;
- "(D) FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS FROM THE EFFECTIVITY OF THIS ACT, THE PNPA SHALL CONTINUE TO ACCOMMODATE CADETS FOR THE BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY (BJMP) AND THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP): PROVIDED, THAT THIS PERIOD MAY BE EXTENDED BY THE PNP UPON THE REQUEST OF THE BJMP AND BFP IN CASE THE PPSC IS STILL NOT ABLE TO PROVIDE THE EDUCATION AND TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE TWO (2) BUREAUS. PURSUANT THERETO, THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), IN

1	CONSULTATION WITH THE PPSC, IS HEREBY
2	AUTHORIZED TO CREATE A SEPARATE ACADEMY FOR
3	THE BJMP AND BFP. THEREAFTER, THE PNPA
4	SHALL PRODUCE GRADUATES WHO WILL EXCLUSIVELY
5	JOIN THE PNP; AND
6	"(E) THE SECRETARY OF THE DILG AND EX
7	OFFICIO CHAIRMAN OF THE NAPOLCOM SHALL
8	FORMULATE AND IMPLEMENT A FIVE (5)-YEAR
9	TRANSITION PLAN TO ENSURE THE SMOOTH TRANSFER
10	OF THE PNPA AND NPTI TO THE PNP."
11	SEC. 7. Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this
12	Act, the NAPOLCOM, in coordination with the PNP, PPSC and
13	DILG, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to
14	implement the provisions of this Act.
15	SEC. 8. The amount necessary for the initial implementation
16	of this Act shall be charged against the current year's
17	appropriations of the Philippine National Police Academy and the
18	National Police Training Institute under the Philippine Public
19	Safety College. Thereafter, such amount as may be necessary for its
20	continued implementation shall be included in the annual General
21	Appropriations Act.
22	SEC. 9. In case any provision of this Act or any portion hereof
23	is declared unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall not be
24	affected thereby.
25	SEC. 10. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and
26	regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof which are
27	inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended, or
28	modified accordingly.

SEC. 11. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
