AN ACT RENAMING THE STRETCH OF ROAD CURRENTLY KNOWN AS THE NORTH LUZON EXPRESSWAY (NLEX), BARANGAY BALINTAWAK IN THAT TRAVERSES QUEZON CITY, THE CITIES OF CALOOCAN AND VALENZUELA IN METRO MANILA, THROUGH THE CITY OF MEYCAUAYAN, THE MUNICIPALITIES OF MARILAO, BOCAUE, BALAGTAS, GUIGUINTO, THE CITY OF MALOLOS, THE MUNICIPALITIES OF PLARIDEL AND PULILAN, ALL IN THE PROVINCE OF BULACAN, THROUGH THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN SIMON, THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, THE MUNICIPALITY OF MEXICO, THE CITY OF ANGELES, UP TO BARANGAY STA. INES IN THE CITY OF MABALACAT, ALL IN THE PROVINCE OF PAMPANGA, AND WHICH MERGES WITH MACARTHUR HIGHWAY AND CONTINUES NORTHWARD INTO THE REST OF CENTRAL AND NORTHERN LUZON, TO MARCELO H. DEL PILAR EXPRESSWAY (MHDPEX)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The stretch of road currently known as the North
- 2 Luzon Expressway (NLEX), that traverses Barangay Balintawak in
- 3 Quezon City, through the cities of Caloocan and Valenzuela in

1	Metro Manila, through the City of Meycauayan, the municipalities
2	of Marilao, Bocaue, Balagtas, Guiguinto, the City of Malolos, the
3	municipalities of Plaridel and Pulilan, all in the Province of
4	Bulacan, through the Municipality of San Simon, the City of San
5	Fernando, the Municipality of Mexico, the City of Angeles, up to
6	Barangay Sta. Ines in the City of Mabalacat, all in the Province of
7	Pampanga, and which merges with MacArthur Highway and
8	continues northward into the rest of Central and Northern Luzon, is
9	hereby renamed Marcelo H. Del Pilar Expressway (MHDPEX).
10	SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall
11	issue the necessary rules, orders, and circulars to implement the
12	provisions of this Act within sixty (60) days from its effectivity.
13	SEC. 3 This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
14	publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
