Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. October 28 of every year is hereby declared a
special nonworking holiday in the Municipality of Dingle, Province
of Iloilo to commemorate the "Cry of Lincud", the first declaration of
the revolution against Spain in the Island of Panay.

5 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its 6 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general 7 circulation.
