AN ACT DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITIES OF STO. DOMINGO. STA. CATALINA, BANTAY. SAN ILDEFONSO, SAN VICENTE, SINAIT, CABUGAO, SAN JUAN, MAGSINGAL AND CAOAYAN, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS SUR AS TOURIST DESTINATIONS. PROVIDING FOR THEIR DEVELOPMENT APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The municipalities of Sto. Domingo, Sta. Catalina, Bantay, San Ildefonso, San Vicente, Sinait, Cabugao, San Juan, Magsingal and Caoayan, Province of Ilocos Sur are hereby declared as tourist destinations. As such, their development shall be prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of tourist destinations.

SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in coordination with the concerned local government units and government agencies, shall prepare a tourism development plan involving the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure as shall enhance tourism in these municipalities: *Provided*, That said development plan shall

ensure the preservation and conservation of natural resources thereat.

SEC. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the tourism development plan that will suit the natural characteristics of the municipalities and shall incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year.

It shall also be the responsibility of the DOT to promote the municipalities as tourist destinations in all its national, regional and local promotion programs.

SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act and internally generated funds of the DOT.

SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of the DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its proper implementation.

SEC. 6. All laws, rules, regulations, proclamations, executive orders or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended accordingly.

SEC. 7. If any section or part of this Act is held unconstitutional, no other section or provision shall be affected.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
