AN ACT DECLARING THE POLILLO GROUP OF ISLANDS OF POLILLO, BURDEOS, PANUKULAN, PATNANUNGAN AND JOMALIG AND THE CAGBALETE ISLAND IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAUBAN, PROVINCE OF QUEZON A TOURISM ZONE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Polillo Group of Islands of Polillo, Burdeos, Panukulan, Patnanungan and Jomalig and the Cagbalete Island in the Municipality of Mauban, Province of Quezon are hereby declared a tourism zone.

SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the Department of Tourism (DOT), in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan involving the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure as shall enhance tourism in said islands: *Provided*, That the development plan shall ensure the preservation, protection and enhancement of the natural features, historic significance and cultural heritage of the tourism zone, while providing sustainable economic opportunities for the local community.

- SEC. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the tourism development plan and incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year.
- SEC. 4. The DOT and its concerned attached agencies may provide the necessary technical and financial assistance for the development of tourism infrastructure and the conduct of skills development in concerned local government units and promote the tourism zone both locally and internationally.
- SEC. 5. The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), in coordination with the DOT, shall set in place the necessary construction and improvement of roads and other infrastructure upon the promulgation of this Act and incorporate these in the DPWH's infrastructure program.
- SEC. 6. The DOT and concerned local government units shall organize a forum by which the private sector, nongovernment organizations and other interest groups can interact with one another and create an atmosphere that shall encourage investment and develop a culture of tourism.
- SEC. 7. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its proper implementation.
 - SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
