AN ACT EXPANDING THE COVERAGE OF THE MANDATORY
BASIC IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM AND PROVIDING A
SYSTEM IN THE DETERMINATION OF OTHER TYPES
OF VACCINE-PREVENTABLE DISEASES, AMENDING
FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10152,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "MANDATORY INFANTS
AND CHILDREN HEALTH IMMUNIZATION ACT OF 2011"

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Republic Act No. 10152, otherwise
2 known as the "Mandatory Infants and Children Health
3 Immunization Act of 2011", is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "SEC. 3. *Coverage.* – The mandatory basic
5 immunization for all infants and children provided
6 under this Act shall cover the following
7 vaccine-preventable diseases:

8 "(a) Tuberculosis;

1 “(b) Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis;

2 “(c) Poliomyelitis;

3 “(d) Measles;

4 “(e) Mumps;

5 “(f) Rubella or German measles;

6 “(g) Hepatitis-B;

7 “(h) H. Influenza type B (HIB); [and]

8 “(I) ROTAVIRUS;

9 “(J) JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS;

10 “(K) PNEUMOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE
11 (PCV);

12 “(L) HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUS (HPV); AND

13 [i] “(M) Such other types as may be determined by
14 the Secretary of Health in a department circular[.]
15 UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE FORMULARY
16 EXECUTIVE COUNCIL (FEC) AND THE NATIONAL
17 IMMUNIZATION COMMITTEE (NIC) CREATED AS AN
18 ADVISORY GROUP TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL SUPPORT TO
19 THE SETTING OF A DOH POLICY DIRECTION ON THE
20 NATIONAL IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM (NIP), AND
21 AFTER SEPARATE OR JOINT PUBLIC HEARINGS
22 CONDUCTED BY THE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND
23 DEMOGRAPHY OF THE SENATE AND THE COMMITTEE
24 ON HEALTH OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
25 *PROVIDED*, THAT WHEN THERE IS A PANDEMIC AND
26 WHEN THE CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES IS NOT IN

1 SESSION, THE SAID PUBLIC HEARINGS NEED NOT BE
2 CONDUCTED.

3 "XXX."

4 SEC. 2. A new section to be numbered as Section 7 is hereby
5 added after Section 6 of the same Act, to read as follows:

6 "SEC. 7. *ANNUAL REPORT.* - THE DOH SHALL
7 SUBMIT TO THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE
8 PHILIPPINES, THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH
9 AND DEMOGRAPHY, AND THE HOUSE OF
10 REPRESENTATIVES COMMITTEE ON HEALTH ON OR
11 BEFORE THE END OF DECEMBER OF EVERY YEAR, OR
12 UPON THE REQUEST OF ANY OF THE AFORESAID
13 COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS, A REPORT GIVING A
14 DETAILED ACCOUNT OF THE STATUS OF THE
15 IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT."

16 SEC. 3. Sections 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of the same Act are hereby
17 renumbered as Sections 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, respectively.

18 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
19 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
20 circulation.
