- AN ACT ESTABLISHING A JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY MAGANHAN, BAYBAY CITY, PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO BE KNOWN AS MAGANHAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision
of the Department of Education, a junior high school in Barangay
Maganhan, Baybay City, Province of Leyte to be known as
Maganhan Junior High School.

5 SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include 6 in the Department's program the operationalization of the 7 Maganhan Junior High School, the funding of which shall be 8 included in the annual General Appropriations Act. 1 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules 2 and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act within one 3 hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

4 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its 5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general 6 circulation.
