AN ACT DECLARING A PARCEL OF PUBLIC LAND LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PIKIT, PROVINCE OF COTABATO, AN AGRICULTURAL LAND OPEN TO DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT FOR AGRICULTURAL, RESIDENTIAL, INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL, OR OTHER PRODUCTIVE PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The parcel of public land identified as Forestry Project
- 2 No. 5-A, consisting of fifty-three million three hundred thirty thousand
- 3 (53,330,000) square meters, more or less, located in barangays Punol,
- 4 Katilacan, Balong, Bulol, Paidu Pulangi, Bago-Ingued, Buliok, Barongis,
- 5 Kabasalan, Makabual and Mañaulanan, in the Municipality of Pikit,
- 6 Province of Cotabato is hereby declared an agricultural land open to
- 7 disposition to qualified beneficiaries for agricultural, residential, industrial,
- 8 commercial, or other productive purposes.

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SEC. 2. Ninety (90) days following the effectivity of this Act, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), in coordination with the Provincial Governor of Cotabato; National Housing Authority, Region XII; Sangguniang Bayan of Pikit; Municipal Mayor of Pikit; concerned barangay captains; farmers' organization duly accredited by the Municipal Government of Pikit; and Representative of the First District of Cotabato, shall subdivide the parcel of land covered under Section 1 hereof and award, except those areas reserved pursuant to Section 5 hereof, lots appropriate for agricultural, residential, industrial, commercial, or other productive purpose to qualified beneficiaries in accordance with the pertinent provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 141, otherwise known as "The Public Land Act", as amended, Republic Act No. 730, entitled "An Act to Permit the Sale Without Public Auction of Public Lands of the Republic of the Philippines for Residential Purposes to Qualified Applicants Under Certain Conditions", and other existing laws

on land acquisition and ownership: *Provided*, That the size or extent of each lot intended for agricultural development or farming shall be uniform but not greater than three hectares.

SEC. 3. In the determination of qualified beneficiaries over the lots allotted for agricultural development, which shall be issued free patents, the DENR shall give priority to those persons who do not own any parcel of land, or have not had the benefit of any gratuitous allotment of more than three hectares of agricultural land anywhere in the country, or who by themselves or through their predecessors in interest have been in open, continuous, exclusive, and notorious possession and occupation, except when prevented by war or *force majeure*, of any parcel of land within the area subject of this Act.

The determination of beneficiaries and mode of disposition of the lots suitable for residential, industrial, commercial, and other productive purpose other than agricultural development shall be in accordance with the pertinent provisions of Chapter IX, Title III, of the Public Land Act, as amended.

SEC. 4. Except in favor of the government or any of its branches, units, or institutions, lands acquired under the provisions of this Act shall not be subject to encumbrance or alienation for a term of ten (10) years from the date of the issuance of land patent, nor shall they become liable to the satisfaction of any debt contracted prior to the expiration of said

- 1 period. No transfer or alienation made within the said period of ten (10)
- 2 years from the issuance of such patent except those made by virtue of the
- 3 right of succession shall be valid unless when duly authorized by the
- 4 Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources and the transferee or
- 5 vendee is a Filipino citizen. Every conveyance made shall be subject to
- 6 repurchase by the original owner or beneficiary of this Act or his legal
- 7 heirs within a period of five years from the date of conveyance.
- 8 Any contract or agreement made or executed in violation of this
- 9 section shall be void ab initio.
- 10 SEC. 5. In coordination with the Municipal Government of Pikit
- and concerned barangays, the DENR shall establish tree nurseries in the
- 12 area and reserve certain sections that are vulnerable to erosion, landslides,
- 13 flooding, and similar events as greenbelt areas or permanent forest
- 14 reserves: Provided, That the total forest reserves shall not exceed five
- percent (5%) of the to all land area.
- 16 SEC. 6. The National Housing Authority shall implement a
- 17 socialized housing project in the area. Said housing project shall be
- supported by the Department of Trade and Industry and its attached offices
- 19 with a comprehensive economic development plan that includes credit
- 20 facilities, marketing assistance, extension services, agro-industrial
- 21 processing plants, and other livelihood opportunities.

l	SEC. 7. Within thirty (30) days following the effectivity of this
2	Act, the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, in coordination
3	with concerned government agencies, shall promulgate the necessary rules
4	and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
5	SEC. 8. If any part or section of this Act is declared
6	unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the other parts or
7	sections of this Act.
8	SEC. 9. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders,
9	proclamations, rules and regulations inconsistent with any provision of this
10	Act shall be deemed re pealed or modified accordingly.
1	SEC. 10. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
12	publication in the Official Gazette or in two national newspapers of
13	general circulation.
