AN ACT TO EXTEND THE UTILIZATION PERIOD OF AGRICULTURAL COMPETITIVENESS ENHANCEMENT FUND. AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8178, ENTITLED "AN ACT REPLACING QUANTITATIVE IMPORT RESTRICTIONS ON AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS, EXCEPT RICE, WITH TARIFFS, CREATING THE AGRICULTURAL COMPETITIVENESS ENHANCEMENT FUND, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Section 8 of Republic Act No. 8178, entitled "An Act
- 2 Replacing Quantitative Import Restrictions on Agricultural Products, Except
- 3 Rice, With Tariffs, Creating the Agricultural Competitiveness Enhancement
- 4 Fund, and for Other Purposes" is hereby amended, to read as follows:
- 5 "SEC. 8. Agricultural Competitiveness Enhancement Fund.
- 6 To implement the policy enunciated in this Act, there is hereby

created the Agricultural Competitiveness Enhancement Fund, hereinafter referred to as the Fund. [The proceeds of] THE FUND SHALL CONSIST OF ALL DUTIES COLLECTED FROM the importation of AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS UNDER THE minimum access volume (MAV) [shall accrue to the General Fund and shall deposited with the National Treasury MECHANISM. INCLUDING UNUSED BALANCE AND COLLECTIONS FROM REPAYMENTS LOÀN BENEFICIARIES FROM INCLUDING INTERESTS, IF ANY. THE FUND SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY CREDITED TO SPECIAL ACCOUNT 183 IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE NATIONAL TREASURY.

The entire proceeds shall be set aside and earmarked by Congress for irrigation, farm-to-market roads, post-harvest equipment and facilities, credit, research and development, other marketing infrastructure, provision of market information, retraining, extension services, MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (MSMSE) SCALE IN AGRICULTURE, AQUACULTURE SECTORS: **FISHERIES** YOUNG AND ENTREPRENEURS, OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH, GRADUATES OF COURSES: AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES RELATED AND AGRICULTURE AND FISHERY COOPERATIVES ENGAGED IN

1	ECONOMIC ENTERPRISES and other forms of assistance and
2	support to the agricultural sector.
3	The Committees on Agriculture and Food, Appropriations
4	and Finance of both the Senate and the House of Representatives
5	shall conduct a periodic review of the use of the Fund. The Fund
6	shall [have a life of nine (9) years] EXIST UNTIL THE YEAR 2015,
7	after which all remaining balances shall revert to the General
8	Fund."
9	SEC. 2. A new section is hereby inserted after Section 8 [of R.
10	8178] to be designated as Section 9 to read as follows;
11	SEC. 9. OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE - AN OVERSIGHT
12	COMMITTEE IS HEREBY CREATED COMPOSED OF FIVE
13	MEMBERS EACH FROM THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
14	REPRESENTATIVES TO MONITOR AND EVALUATE THE
15	IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT.
16	THE CHAIRPERSONS OF THE COMMITTEES ON
17	AGRICULTURE AND FOOD OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
18	REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE THE CHAIRPERSON AND CO-
19	CHAIRPERSON, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE OVERSIGHT
20	COMMITTEE: PROVIDED, THAT THE MINORITY IN THE
21	SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE

1	ENTITLED TO NOT LESS THAN TWO SEATS EACH IN THE
- 2	OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.
3	THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE SHALL BE PROVIDED
4	WITH THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO CARRY OUT ITS DUTIES
5	RELATED TO THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTIONS AS
6	PROVIDED HEREIN.
7	The succeeding sections shall be renumbered accordingly.
8	SEC. 3. Repealing Clause All laws, decrees, executive issuances
9	rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified
10	accordingly.
11	SEC. 4. Separability Clause The provisions of this Act are hereby
12	declared to be separable, and in the event one or more of such provisions are
13	held unconstitutional, the validity of the other provisions shall not be affected
14	thereby.
15	SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of its
16	publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two newspapers of general
17	circulation.
