AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE CAMARINES SUR BAMBUSETUM THAT SHALL CONTRIBUTE TO THE EX SITU CONSERVATION OF PHILIPPINE BAMBOO SPECIES AND TO ASSEMBLE IN A SELECTED SITE OR SITES IN THE PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR A COLLECTION OF TROPICAL AND SUBTROPICAL BAMBOO TAXONS FROM OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD AND, TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, TO ADAPT TO THE PHILIPPINE CLIMATE SOME TEMPERATE BAMBOO TAXONS THAT CAN SURVIVE AND BE PROPAGATED IN THE PHILIPPINES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared the policy of
- 2 the State:
- 3 (a) To provide a sound basis for experimentation, pilot demonstration
- 4 and eventual commercialization of bamboo species for various uses;

(b) To recognize that native bamboo species as a genetic resource may become endangered unless an institutional vehicle is provided for their conservation and preservation; and

- (c) To plant on a selected site or sites a collection of tropical and subtropical bamboo species and, to the extent practicable, to adapt to the local climate suitable temperate bamboo species that can survive and be propagated in Camarines Sur.
- SEC. 2. Creation of Bambusetum. There shall be created in the Province of Camarines Sur a bambusetum which shall be under the control and supervision of the provincial government of Camarines Sur. The establishment of said bambusetum shall be provided with technical and financial assistance by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), and the latter shall also arrange to provide the Camarines Sur Bambusetum the initial core of planting materials of different native bamboo taxons including those that have been introduced in the Philippines and have survived, grown and flourished within the Philippine environmental setting.

The bambusetum shall be located in such appropriate location(s) with such topsoil conditions and climatic characteristics as shall be suitable for the cultivation of varied bamboo species. The land area where the bambusetum shall be established shall be in not less than fifteen (15) hectares that the provincial government of Camarines Sur may acquire by means of purchase or

- donation. Alternatively, whenever the national government has public lands in
- 2 the province, the DENR is hereby authorized to delineate, specify and allocate,
- 3 by way of grant to the provincial government of Camarines Sur, such land
- 4 areas as shall be deemed appropriate, necessary and expedient to accomplish
- 5 the objectives and purposes of a bambusetum.
- 6 SEC. 3. Powers and Functions of the Bambusetum. The Camarines
- 7 Sur Bambusetum shall have the following powers and functions.
- 8 (a) Establish bamboo plantations of different bamboo species;
- 9 (b) Create information exchange programs with similar institutions
- 10 locally and internationally on the different bamboo species and their respective
- 11 propagation techniques;
- (c) Study and apply the various uses not only of standing bamboo
- species but also the use of different products that may be derived from such
- 14 bamboo species;
- 15 (d) Undertake research and development activities on the various
- processing technologies for bamboo products;
- (e) Provide technical and other advisory services to bamboo growers,
- processors, manufacturers, traders and distributors of bamboo products;
- 19 (f) Set up its facilities in a manner that serves as a venue for
- 20 educational activities as well as a source of information about the bamboo
- 21 industry; and

- 1 (g) Organize and make its facilities available for tours and for the
- 2 conduct of seminars and workshops on the various aspects of the bamboo
- 3 industry.
- 4 SEC. 4. This Act shall take immediate effect upon its approval.
