AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SPECIALIZED NATIONAL SCHOOL FOR  
THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED IN THE CAPITAL TOWN OF  
PILI IN THE PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR TO BE KNOWN  
AS THE CAMARINES SUR INTEGRATED SCHOOL FOR  
SPECIAL CHILDREN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1       SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the Department of  
2 Education, a specialized school providing for elementary and secondary  
3 education to the physically handicapped in the Capital Town of Pili in the  
4 Province of Camarines Sur to be known as the Camarines Sur Integrated  
5 School for Special Children.

6       SEC. 2. The education and training to be provided in said specialized  
7 school shall cover those who are deaf, mute or blind as well as others who may

1 be suffering from physical infirmities or handicaps, inborn or acquired, who  
2 may not be able to properly cope with studies in regularly established schools  
3 because of the special needs demanded or warranted by their infirmities or  
4 handicaps.

5 Accordingly, the physical structure of the school, classrooms, seating  
6 arrangements and teaching materials, and other equipment that are deemed  
7 suitable for the efficient and effective training and education of the physically  
8 handicapped shall be provided in said school.

9 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the  
10 Department's program the operationalization of the Camarines Sur Integrated  
11 School for Special Children, the funding of which shall be included in the  
12 annual General Appropriations Act.

13 SEC. 4. Grants, donations or bequests of equipment, teaching and  
14 reading materials, and other educational aids required by said school shall be  
15 exempt from donor's tax and the same shall be considered as allowable  
16 deductions from the gross income in the computation of the income tax of the  
17 donor, in accordance with the provisions of the National Internal Revenue  
18 Code, as amended: *Provided, however,* That such donations shall not be  
19 disposed of, transferred or sold.

20 The School can also import duty-free economic, technical and cultural  
21 books and/or publications upon certification of the Department of Education

1 that such books and/or publications are for economic, technical, vocational,  
2 scientific, philosophical, historical or cultural purposes, in accordance with the  
3 provisions of the Tariff and Customs Code, as amended.

4 SEC. 5. This Act shall take immediate effect upon its approval.
