AN ACT DECLARING THE CULMINATION OF MUSLIM ANNUAL HAJJ A NATIONAL HOLIDAY FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF EIDUL ADHA, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 26, CHAPTER 7 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 292, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987, AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The culmination of the Muslim annual hajj is hereby
- declared a national holiday for the observance of Eidul Adha. This is the last day
- 3 marking the end of Muslim hajj in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
- SEC. 2. Section 26, Chapter 7 of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise
- 5 known as the Revised Administrative Code of 1987, as amended, is hereby
- 6 further amended to read as follows:

1	SEC. 3. The implementation of this Act shall be under the supervision of
2	the Office of Muslim Affairs, which shall promulgate rules and regulations
3	pursuant to the provisions of this Act, upon consultation with the Grand Mufti.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in at least two national newspapers of general circulation.
