AN ACT DECLARING JUNE 30 OF EVERY YEAR AS A DAY OF CELEBRATION TO COMMEMORATE PHILIPPINE FEMINISM

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. June 30 of every year is hereby declared a day of 2 celebration to commemorate the founding of the first formal national feminist 3 organization in the country, *Asociacion Feminista Filipina*, on June 30, 1905. 4 This special day shall also commemorate Philippine feminism and accord due 5 recognition to the invaluable roles that women have played in nation-building 6 in the national struggle for freedom and in advancing their status in society 7 through the years.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
