	AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS 91 AND 97 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8550, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "PHILIPPINE FISHERIES CODE OF 1998"
	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
l	SECTION 1. Section 91 of Republic Act No. 8550, otherwise known as
2	the "Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998", is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	"SEC. 91. Ban on Coral Exploitation and Exportation
4	It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to gather,
5	possess, sell or export ordinary precious and semi-precious
5	corals, whether raw or in processed form, except for scientific or
7	research purposes.
8	"Violations of this provision shall be punished by
9	imprisonment from six (6) months to two (2) years and a fine

1	from Two thousand pesos (P2,000) to Twenty thousand pesos
2	(P20,000), or both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion
3	of the court, and forfeiture of the subject corals, including the
4	vessel and its proper disposition.

"The confiscated corals shall either be returned to the sea or donated to schools and museums for educational or scientific purposes or disposed through other means.

"ANY SPECIES OF CORAL THAT IS ARTIFICIALLY CULTURED OR PROPAGATED PURSUANT TO PUBLISHED RULES REGULATIONS AND TO BE **PROMULGATED** BY THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE ALLOWED AND EXEMPTED FROM THE PROHIBITIONS OF THIS SECTION."

SEC. 2. Section 97 of Republic Act No. 8550 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 97. Fishing or Taking of Rare, Threatened or Endangered Species. - It shall be unlawful to fish or TO WILLFULLY take rare, threatened or endangered species FROM THE WILD, as listed in the CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE OF ENDANGERED SPECIES OF FLORA AND FAUNA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS CITES, and as [determined] **IMPLEMENTED** Department by the PURSUANT TO PUBLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1	"THE TERM 'THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES'
2	IN THE CONTEXT OF THIS SECTION AND FOR CLARIFICATION
3	OF THE PENALTY PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL MEAN ANY
4	OF THE RARE MARINE LIFE CONSISTING OF THE SPECIES
5	LISTED IN THE CITES, BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SPECIES
6	THAT ARE ARTIFICIALLY PROPAGATED OR BRED IN CAPTIVITY.
7	"Violation of the provision of this section shall be
8	punished by imprisonment of twelve (12) years to twenty (20)
9	years and/or a fine of One hundred and twenty thousand pesos
10	(P120,000) and forfeiture of the eatch, and the cancellation of
11	fishing permit.
12	"SHOULD THE CULPABLE VIOLATION BE THROUGH OR
13	BY A FISHING VESSEL MANNED BY MORE THAN TWO PERSONS,
14	THE HEAD OR CAPTAIN OF THE BOAT AND THE SUPPORT
15	PERSONNEL THEREOF INVOLVED IN THE FISHING AND
16	CATCHING OF SUCH PROTECTED MARINE LIFE SHALL BE
17	PRESUMED TO HAVE COMMITTED THE PROHIBITED ACT AND
18	THE PENALTY PROVIDED FOR IN THE IMMEDIATELY
19	PRECEDING PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IMPOSED ON THEM."
20	SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
21	in a newspaper of general circulation.
