AN ACT PROVIDING PRIVATE WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES WOMEN AND GENDER EDUCATION IN THE WORKPLACE FURTHER AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
SECTION 1. Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended, is hereby further
amended by inserting a new Article 210, to be denominated as Article 210-A
to read as follows:
"ART. 210-A. WOMEN AND GENDER EDUCATION EVERY
EMPLOYER SHALL GIVE HIS OR HER WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES
FREE ANNUAL EDUCATION SEMINARS IN THE WORKPLACE ON
MANAGEME BLOWNS WAY THE LAND WAYER OR COMPANY

EQUALITY, RELEVANT LAWS SUCH AS REPUBLIC ACT No. 7877

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OR THE 'ANTI-SEXUAL HARASSMENT ACT OF 1995', REPUBLIC
ACT No. 9208 OR THE 'ANTI-TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS ACT OF
2003', REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9262 OR THE 'ANTI-VIOLENCE
AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN ACT', AND REPUBLIC
ACT NO. 8972 OR THE 'SOLO PARENTS' WELFARE ACT', AND
SUCH OTHER RELATED LAWS THAT MAY BE LATER ENACTED,
USING PARTICIPATORY AND NONFORMAL EDUCATION MODULES
PRESCRIBED BY THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON THE ROLE OF
FILIPINO WOMEN, AND WOMEN'S ORGANIZATIONS, TRAINING
AND RESOURCE CENTERS AND INSTITUTES.

FOR THIS PURPOSE, THE SECRETARY OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON THE ROLE OF FILIPINO WOMEN, OTHER CONCERNED AGENCIES, AND NONGOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS PROMOTING WOMEN'S RIGHTS, WELFARE AND PROTECTION TO MONITOR THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WOMEN AND GENDER EDUCATION PROGRAM PROVIDED HEREIN."

SEC. 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations. – Within thirty (30) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Labor and Employment shall issue and publish the rules and regulations to effectively implement the provisions of this Act.

1	SEC. 3. Repealing Clause All other acts, laws, executive orders,
2	presidential issuances, rules and regulations or any part thereof which are
3	inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.
4	SEC. 4. Effectivity: Clause - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
5	days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two newspapers
6	of general circulation.
