26 SEC. 2. *Use of Funds.* – The amount herein appropriated shall be used
27 for the purposes indicated and subject to the applicable Special Provisions

1 under Republic Act No. 9336, the FY 2005 General Appropriations Act, as
2 reenacted: *Provided*, That the following conditions shall be applicable:

3 A. The amount of One billion pesos (P1,000,000,000.00) appropriated
4 under Section 1:B shall be directly released to, and administered by, the
5 Department of Public Works and Highways based on the work program
6 submitted by the DepEd: *Provided*, That the amount of Five hundred million
7 pesos (P500,000,000.00) shall be for the construction, replacement and
8 completion of school buildings and Five hundred million pesos
9 (P500,000,000.00) shall be for the rehabilitation and repair of school
10 buildings;

11 B. Upgrading of salaries of uniformed personnel of the BFP and BJMP
12 and the increase in basic pay of PPSC Cadets shall be effective July 1, 2006;

13 C. Miscellaneous Personnel Benefits Fund:

14 1. Release of the increase in government counterpart contribution due
15 ECC starting 2006 shall be subject to ECC Board approval of a rationalized
16 benefit scheme: *Provided*, That any new increase in government counterpart
17 contributions may only be made after consultation with the Department of
18 Budget and Management (DBM); and

19 2. Release of deficiencies in government counterpart contributions due:
20 (i) HDMF, from July 1997 and prior years shall be subject to reconciliation of
21 accounts between DBM and HDMF; and (ii) GSIS, representing deficiency
22 from July 1997 to December 1998 shall, notwithstanding any provision of law
23 to the contrary, be considered as payment on the principal and not on any
24 interest due thereon: *Provided*, That any interest, surcharge, penalty or other
25 similar charges imposed for late remittances due on the foregoing amount and
26 on the unremitted share of the national government and prior years are hereby
27 condoned and extinguished: *Provided, finally*, That GSIS undertakes to

1 reimburse all retirees whose retirement and other benefits were reduced by
2 reason of such deficiency in employer's counterpart contributions.

3 D. The amounts appropriated under Philippine Veterans Affairs Office,
4 Pension and Gratuity Fund, shall be used to pay the validated arrearages in old
5 age pension due to World War II Veterans.

6 SEC. 3. *Automatic Appropriations.* – The amount stated under Section
7 1.L (ALGU-IRA) is considered automatically appropriated. Future local
8 government share in the national internal revenue taxes or IRA shall henceforth
9 be automatically appropriated.

10 SEC. 4. *Release of Funds.* – The amounts appropriated herein shall be
11 released to the departments, bureaus, offices, agencies and LGUs by the DBM
12 in accordance with budgeting laws, rules and regulations.

13 SEC. 5. *Oversight Committee.* – There is hereby created a Joint
14 Congressional Oversight Committee to oversee the utilization of the Two
15 billion pesos (P2,000,000,000.00) appropriated for the Guimaras Oil Spill. The
16 Committee shall be composed of ten Members with five (5) members each
17 from the Senate and the House of Representatives: *Provided*, That Members
18 of the Minority shall be adequately represented.

19 SEC. 6. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – The DBM shall issue
20 the necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Act
21 including, but not limited to, the upgrading of salaries of uniformed personnel
22 of the BFP and BJMP and the increase in basic pay of PPSC Cadets.

23 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect upon its enactment into
24 law.
