AN ACT SEPARATING THE PAGADIAN CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL - ANNEX IN BARANGAY LOWER SIBATANG, PAGADIAN CITY, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR FROM THE PAGADIAN CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY DANLUGAN, PAGADIAN CITY, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE OTTO LINGUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
- 2 - The Pagadian City National High School - Annex in Barangay Lower
- 3 Sibatang, Pagadian City, Province of Zamboanga del Sur is hereby separated
- 4 from the Pagadian City National High School in Barangay Danlujan, Pagadian
- 5 City, Province of Zamboanga del Sur and converted into an independent
- 6 national high school to be known as the Otto Lingue National High School.

1 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
2 liabilities and records of the Pagadian City National High School – Annex in
3 Barangay Lower Sibatang, Pagadian City, Province of Zamboanga del Sur are
4 hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Otto Lingue National High School.

5 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
6 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the
7 Otto Lingue National High School, the initial funding of which shall be
8 charged against the current year’s appropriations of the Pagadian City National
9 High School – Annex in Barangay Lower Sibatang. Thereafter, the amount
10 necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the
11 annual General Appropriations Act.

12 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such
13 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

14 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
15 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
