AN ACT MOVING THE OBSERVANCE OF RIZAL DAY FROM DECEMBER 30 TO JUNE 19, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 26, CHAPTER 7, BOOK I OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 292, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26, Chapter 7, Book I of Executive Order No. 292, as amended, otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987, is hereby 2 3 further amended to read as follows: 4 "SEC. 26. Regular Holidays and Nationwide Special 5 Days. - (1) Unless otherwise modified by law, order or proclamation, the following regular holidays and special days 6 7 shall be observed in the country: "a) 8 Regular Holidays
- 9 New Year's Day January I 10 Maundy Thursday - Movable Date

23	"Provided, That for movable holidays, the President shal				
24	issue a proclamation, at least six months prior to the holiday				
25	concerned, the specific date that shall be declared as a				
26	nonworking day:				

"Provided, however, That Eidul Adha shall be celebrated
as a regional holiday in the Autonomous Region in Muslim
Mindanao."
SEC. 2. All laws, orders, presidential issuances, rules and regulations of
parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified
accordingly.
SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its
publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
