	AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MULTI-SPECIES MARINE HATCHERY IN THE CITY OF ZAMBOANGA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR
	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
1	SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Bureau of Fisheries and
2	Aquatic Resources of the Department of Agriculture (BFAR-DA), a multi-species marine hatchery in the
3	City of Zamboanga.
. 4	
5	SEC. 2. The BFAR-DA shall transfer the management of the multi-species marine hatchery to the
6	local government of Zamboanga City within two (2) years after its construction through a memorandum of
7	agreement. It shall implement a training and phasing-in program for local government personnel on the
8	management and operation of the hatchery.
9	
10	The BFAR-DA shall conduct continuing research and experimentation on the breeding and
11	production of marine species, especially as they apply to local conditions, to discover new methods and
12	technology that shall benefit the fisheries industry.
13	
14	SEC. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the
15	establishment of the multi-species marine hatchery in the City of Zamboanga, the funding of which shall
16	be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The local government unit concerned shall set aside
17	funds from any available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the
18	hatchery.
19	
20	Sec. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall
21	issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, monitoring, and the transfer of the management of the
22	multi-species marine hatchery to the City of Zamboanga.
23	
24	Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in
25	a newspaper of general circulation.
