AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE COMPOSTELA VALLEY STATE COLLEGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NABUNTURAN, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DE ORO, TO BE KNOWN AS THE COMPOSTELA VALLEY STATE COLLEGE-NABUNTURAN CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress' assembled:

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus Act".

SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the Compostela Valley State College, hereinafter referred to as the College, in the Municipality of Nabunturan, Province of Davao de Oro, to be known as the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus.

SEC. 3. The Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus shall primarily provide short-term technical-vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within the areas which, in the determination of the Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as the Board, of the College are within its competency, and are aligned with the human resource development goals of Davao de Oro and Region XI.

The Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus is also mandated to undertake research and extension services, and provide progressive leadership in these areas.

SEC. 4. The Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus shall be headed by a Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and be appointed or designated by the Board, upon the recommendation of the search committee and the President of the Compostela Valley State College. Such appointment or designation shall be subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards set by the Board.

SEC. 5. The Compostela Valley State College shall ensure that the minimum requirements for the operation of the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus, including those related to its course offerings, are fully complied with

SEC. 6. All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus, as well as liabilities or obligations, shall be transferred to the College. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel employed at the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus under existing laws prior to the integration to the College shall be respected.

All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus are hereby declared to be the property of the College and shall be titled under its name: *Provided*, That should Compostela Valley State College cease to exist or be abolished, or should such aforementioned parcels of land be no longer needed by the Compostela Valley State College, the same shall revert to the concerned local government unit or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.

- SEC. 7. The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form part of this Act, and together, shall serve as the Governing Charter of the College.
- SEC. 8. All other powers, functions, privileges, responsibilities, and limitations to College and its officials under existing laws shall be deemed granted to or imposed upon the Compostela Valley State College-Nabunturan Campus and its officials, whenever appropriate.
- SEC. 9. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 10. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.
- SEC. 11. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 12. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
