## AN ACT

TREE DISTINGUISHING THE DAO THE INTEGRATED **SECONDARY FOREST** IN MANAGEMENT AREA OF THE E. PELAEZ RANCH IN BAYOMBONG, BARANGAY CUGMAN, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, AS THE CAGAYAN DECLARING IT **TOURIST** TREE. HERITAGE ATTRACTION, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Dao tree, located within a pocket secondary forest in
- 2 the Integrated Forest Management Agreement area of the E. Pelaez Ranch in
- 3 Bayombong, Barangay Cugman, Cagayan de Oro City, and which is estimated to
- 4 be two hundred (200) years old, is hereby declared the "Cagayan de Oro
- 5 Heritage Tree" and a tourist attraction.
- 6 Sec. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the
- 7 Department of Tourism (DOT), in coordination with the Department of
- 8 Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Cagayan de Oro City Cultural
- 9 Heritage Conservation Council, the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise

- 1 Zone Authority and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a
- 2 tourism development plan involving the promotion of the Cagayan De Oro
- 3 Heritage Tree and its immediate environs as a tourist attraction, construction,
- 4 installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure that
- 5 shall enhance tourism in the area, and the strategies and activities to be
- 6 undertaken to ensure the protection and preservation of the tree.
- 7 Sec. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the tourism
- 8 development plan and incorporate the same in its tourism development program
- 9 for the ensuing calendar year.
- Sec. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in their Department's program
- 11 the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual
- 12 General Appropriations Act and shall augment such allocation with internally
- 13 generated funds of the Department.
- 14 Sec. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the
- 15 Secretary of the DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its
- 16 proper implementation.
- 17 Sec. 6. All laws, rules, regulations, executive orders, presidential decrees
- and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby
- deemed repealed or amended accordingly.
- Sec. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
- 21 the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
