AN ACT

DECLARING THE MALUBAL FALLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ROSELLER T. LIM, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY, AN ECOTOURISM SITE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Malubal Falls Ecotourism 1 Act." 2 3 Sec. 2. Malubal Falls Ecotourism Site. - The Malubal Falls in the Municipality of 4 Roseller T. Lim (RT Lim) in the Second District of Zamboanga Sibugay, is hereby declared an ecotourism site. 5 6 Sec. 3. Malubal Falls Ecotourism Council. - There shall be created the Malubal Falls · 7 Ecotourism Council, hereinafter referred to as the "Council", composed of the following: 8 (a) Mayor of the Municipality of RT Lim, as ex-oficio Chairperson; 9 (b) Regional Director of the Department of Tourism (DOT), as Co-Chairperson; 10 (c) Representative from the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority 11 (TIEZA);

1	(d) Provincial Tourism Officer of the Province of Zamboanga Sibugay;
Ž	(e) Municipal Tourism Officer of the Municipality of RT Lim;
3	(f) One (1) representative from an accredited non-governmental organization whose
4	advocacy is environmental preservation;
5	(g) One (1) representative from a recognized indigenous people's organization; and
6	(h) Two (2) representatives from the private sector whose expertise is in the field of
7	tourism, as members.
8	The local legislative body of the Municipality of RT Lim shall appoint the members
9	of the Council mentioned in paragraphs (f), (g) and (h) for a term of five (5) years, which
10	appointment may be extended to a second term.
11	The municipal tourism office of RT Lim shall act as the Secretariat of the Council
12	and shall provide the funding necessary to cover expenses to be incurred in the performance
13	of its official functions and activities
14	Sec. 4. Functions and Responsibilities of the Council The Council shall exercise the
15	following functions:
16	(a) Study and determine the geographical limits of the site;
17	(b) Formulate the Malubal Falls Development Plan, in consultation with local
18	residents, businesses, and other stakeholders;
19	(c) Assess and evaluate the potential impact of the development to the environmental
20	safety and well-being of the site, communities, and enterprises;
21	(d) Provide technical and financial assistance to communities within the site;
22	(e) Formulate rules and regulations in relation to the maintenance and security of the
23	ecotourism site;
24	(f) Perform other functions as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of this
25	Act.

- Sec. 5. Technical Assistance to the Council. The DOT, TIEZA, Department of
- 2 Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the Department of Public Works and
- 3 Highways (DPWH) shall provide technical assistance to the Council in the performance of its
- 4 functions and responsibilities.
- 5 Sec. 6. Implementing Agencies. The DOT, in coordination with the TIEZA,
- 6 DENR, DPWH and other concerned agencies of government, shall be responsible for the
- 7 monitoring and implementation of the approved Malubal Falls Development Plan.
- 8 Sec. 7, Implementing Rules and Regulations, Within sixty (60) days from the
- 9 effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Tourism shall, in coordination with the Municipality
- 10 of RT Lim, TIEZA and other tourism stakeholders, promulgate the necessary rules and
- regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.
- Sec. 8. Appropriations. The Secretaries of the DOT, DENR and DPWH shall
- include in their respective Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding
- of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act, and shall augment such
- allocation with internally generated funds of the DOT.
- Sec. 9. Repealing Clause. All laws, rules, regulations, proclamations, executive
- orders or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby amended or
- 18 repealed accordingly.
- 19 Sec. 10. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
- 20 in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
