AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A FISH PORT AND FISH PROCESSING FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF OROQUIETA, PROVINCE OF MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department of Agriculture, through the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA), a fish port and fish processing facilities in the City of Oroquieta, Province of Misamis Occidental.

5 SEC. 2. Within two (2) years after the construction of the fish port and fish processing 6 facilities, the PFDA, through a memorandum of agreement, shall transfer their management to 7 the local government of Oroquieta City. The PFDA shall implement a training and phasing-in 8 program for local government personnel on the management and operation of the fish port and 9 fish processing facilities.

11 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the 12 establishment of the fish port and fish processing facilities in Oroquieta City, Province of 13 Misamis Occidental, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General 14 Appropriations Act. The local government unit concerned shall set aside funds from any 15 available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the fish 16 port and fish processing facilities.

18 Sec. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of 19 Agriculture shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, operation, monitoring, and 20 the eventual transfer of the management of the fish port and fish processing facilities to the local 21 government of Oroquieta City.

Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
