AN ACT

DECLARING PINSAL FALLS LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN, A TOURISM DESTINATION, PROVIDING FOR ITS DEVELOPMENT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Pinsal Falls located in the Municipality of San Nicolas, Province of

Pangasinan, is hereby declared a tourism destination. As such, its development shall be

prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing

the development of tourism destinations.

SEC. 2. Within six (6) months after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in coordination

with the Department of Public Works and Highways, the municipal government of San Nicolas

and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan that

shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and

infrastructure that shall enhance tourism in the area: Provided, That said development plan shall

ensure the preservation, conservation and optimum utilization of available assets and resources

in the area.

SEC. 3. The DOT and its concerned attached agencies shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan and incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year. It shall also include Pinsal Falls in all its national, regional and local promotions programs.

SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act, and shall augment such allocation with internally generated funds of the Department.

SEC. 5. All laws, rules, regulations, executive orders, proclamations, presidential decrees and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
