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AN ACT  
CONVERTING THE PINAMUNGAJAN EXTENSION CAMPUS OF THE CEBU  
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (CTU) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
PINAMUNGAJAN, PROVINCE OF CEBU, INTO A REGULAR CAMPUS OF THE  
CTU, TO BE KNOWN AS THE CTU-PINAMUNGAJAN CAMPUS, AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

- 1           **SECTION 1.** This Act shall be known as the "*Cebu Technological University (CTU)*  
2           *Pinamungajan Campus Act*".  
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4           **SEC. 2.** The Pinamungajan Extension Campus of the CTU located in the  
5           Municipality of Pinamungajan, Province of Cebu, is hereby converted into a regular campus  
6           of the CTU, to be known as the CTU-Pinamungajan Campus.  
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8           **SEC. 3.** The CTU-Pinamungajan Campus shall primarily provide short-term  
9           technical-vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within its areas of competency  
10           and specialization, pursuant to the mandate of the CTU, and according to its capabilities as  
11           the Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem necessary to respond  
12           to the human resources development needs of the Province of Cebu and Region VII. It is  
13           also mandated to undertake research and extension services, and to provide progressive  
14           leadership in these areas.  
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16           **SEC. 4.** The CTU-Pinamungajan Campus shall be headed by a Campus Administrator  
17           who shall be appointed by the Board, subject to its guidelines on qualifications and  
18           standards, and based on the recommendation of a search committee duly constituted for the  
19           purpose of selecting the Campus Administrator.  
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21           **SEC. 5.** The CTU shall ensure that the minimum requirements of the Commission on  
22           Higher Education (CHED) for the operation of the CTU-Pinamungajan Campus, including  
23           those related to its course offerings, are fully complied with.

1           **SEC. 6.** All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the Pinamungajan  
2 Extension Campus of the CTU, as well as liabilities or obligations, shall be transferred to  
3 the CTU. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel  
4 therein employed under existing laws prior to its conversion into a regular campus shall be  
5 respected.

7           All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the Pinamungajan  
8 Extension Campus of the CTU shall be transferred to the CTU: *Provided*, That should the  
9 campus or the CTU cease to exist or be abolished or should such aforementioned parcels of  
10 land be no longer needed by the CTU, the same shall revert to the local government unit  
11 concerned or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.  
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13           **SEC. 7.** The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the “Higher  
14 Education Modernization Act of 1997”, shall form part of this Act.  
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16           **SEC. 8.** The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be  
17 included in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).  
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19           The Municipality of Pinamungajan shall provide the same assistance until such time  
20 that the amount necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the CTU-  
21 Pinamungajan Campus shall be included in the annual GAA.  
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23           **SEC. 9.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Board, in  
24 consultation with the CHED, shall determine the implementing rules and regulations to fully  
25 implement the provisions of this Act.  
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27           **SEC. 10.** If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or  
28 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and  
29 effect.  
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31           **SEC. 11.** All other laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and  
32 regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or  
33 modified accordingly.  
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35           **SEC. 12.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
36 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
