AN ACT  
CONVERTING THE SOLANA EXTENSION CAMPUS OF THE CAGAYAN STATE  
UNIVERSITY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLANA, PROVINCE OF CAGAYAN,  
INTO A REGULAR CAMPUS OF THE CAGAYAN STATE UNIVERSITY, TO BE  
KNOWN AS THE "CAGAYAN STATE UNIVERSITY-SOLANA CAMPUS", AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

- 1           **SECTION 1.** This Act shall be known as the "*Cagayan State University (CSU)-Solana*  
2           *Campus Act*".  
3  
4           **SEC. 2.** The Solana Extension Campus of the CSU located in the Municipality of  
5           Solana, Province of Cagayan, is hereby converted into a regular campus, to be known as the  
6           CSU-Solana Campus.  
7  
8           **SEC. 3.** The CSU-Solana Campus shall primarily provide short-term technical-  
9           vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within its areas of competency and  
10          specialization, pursuant to the mandate of the CSU, and according to its capability, as the  
11          Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem necessary to respond to  
12          the human resources development needs of the Province of Cagayan and Region II. It is also  
13          mandated to undertake research and extension services and to provide progressive  
14          leadership in these areas.  
15  
16          **SEC. 4.** The CSU-Solana Campus shall be headed by a Campus Administrator who  
17          shall be appointed by the Board, subject to its guidelines on qualifications and standards,  
18          and based on the recommendation of a search committee duly constituted for the purpose of  
19          selecting the Campus Administrator.  
20  
21          **SEC. 5.** The CSU shall ensure that the minimum requirements of the Commission on  
22          Higher Education (CHED) for the operation of the CSU-Solana Campus, including those  
23          related to its course offerings, are fully complied with.

2       **SEC. 6.** All assets, both real and personal, personnel, and records of the Solana  
3 Extension Campus of the CSU, as well as its liabilities or obligations, shall be transferred to  
4 the CSU. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel  
5 therein employed under existing laws prior to its conversion into a regular campus shall be  
6 respected.  
7

8       All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the Solana Extension  
9 Campus of the CSU shall be transferred to the CSU: *Provided*, That should the CSU-Solana  
10 Campus or the CSU cease to exist or be abolished, or should such aforementioned parcels of  
11 land be no longer needed by the CSU, the same shall revert to the local government unit  
12 concerned or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.  
13

14       **SEC. 7.** The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the “Higher  
15 Education Modernization Act of 1997”, shall form part of this Act.  
16

17       **SEC. 8.** The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included  
18 in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).  
19

20       The Municipality of Solana shall continue to fund the operation and maintenance of the  
21 CSU-Solana Campus until such time that the amount needed to carry out the provisions of  
22 this Act shall be included in the annual GAA.

24       **SEC. 9.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Board shall, in  
25 consultation with the CHED, issue the rules and regulations to fully implement the  
26 provisions of this Act.

28       **SEC. 10.** If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or  
29 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and  
30 effect.

32       **SEC. 11.** All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules, and regulations  
33 contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified  
34 accordingly.

36       **SEC. 12.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*  
37 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
