"AN ACT

EXEMPTING FROM INCOME TAXATION THE HONORARIA, ALLOWANCES, AND OTHER FINANCIAL BENEFITS OF PERSONS RENDERING SERVICE DURING AN ELECTION PERIOD, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 32 (B) (7) OF THE NATIONAL INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1997, AS AMENDED"

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Section 32(B)(7) of the National Internal Revenue Code of 1997, as
- 2 amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

14	SEC. 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations The Department of Finance shall,
15	in consultation with the Commission on Elections and the Department of Education,
16	promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Act within sixty (60)
17	days from its effectivity.
18	SEC. 4. Separability Clause If any portion or provision of this Act is declared
19	void and unconstitutional, the remaining portions or provisions hereof shall not be affected by
20	such declaration.
21	SEC. 3. Repealing Clause All laws, decrees, rules and regulations, and other
22	issuances inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
23	SEC. 5. Effectivity Clause This Act shall take effect after fifteen (15) days
24	following its complete publication either in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
25	circulation.
