## ANACT

## DECLARING THE TAU'T BATO CAVE LOCATED IN BARANGAY RANSANG, MUNICIPALITY OF RIZAL, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN, A TOURISM DESTINATION, PROVIDING FOR ITS DEVELOPMENT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Tau't Bato Cave located in Barangay Ransang, Municipality of Rizal, Province of Palawan, is hereby declared a tourism destination. As such, its 2 development shall be prioritized by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules 3 and regulations governing the development of tourism destinations. 4 5 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in coordination with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the municipal 6
- government of Rizal and other concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance
- 9 of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance tourism in the area:
- *Provided*, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and conservation of the 10
- 11 natural resources in the area.

- SEC. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan
- 2 with due consideration to the natural characteristic of the Tau't Bato Cave, and shall
- 3 incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the calendar year immediately
- 4 succeeding the approval of this Act. It shall also include the Tau't Bato Cave in all its
- 5 national, regional and local promotion programs.
- 6 SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the
- 7 implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
- 8 Appropriations Act, and shall augment such allocation with internally generated funds of
- 9 the Department.
- SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall
- promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 6. All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees and other issuances
- 13 inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended
- 14 accordingly.
- 15 SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
- 16 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
