AN ACT

STRENGTHENING THE FIELD OFFICES OF THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS BY UPGRADING AND CREATING CERTAIN POSITIONS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 53 OF BATAS PAMBANSA BILANG 881, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "OMNIBUS ELECTION CODE," AS AMENDED AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 53 of Batas Pambansa Bilang 881 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 53. Field offices of the Commission. – The Commission shall have the following field offices:

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(1) Regional Election Office, headed by the Regional Election Director WITH THE RANK OF DIRECTOR IV and assisted by the Assistant Regional Director WITH THE RANK OF DIRECTOR III. OTHER OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE ARE REGIONAL ELECTION ATTORNEY. SENIOR ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER V, ACCOUNTANT III, HUMAN MANAGEMENT RESOURCE OFFICER III. OFFICER III. STENOGRAPHIC REPORTER III. WATCHMAN, PROCESS SERVER, ADMINISTRATIVE AIDE IV, ASSISTANT ELECTION SPECIALIST, UTILITY WORKER AND DRIVER II.

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(4) CITY OR MUNICIPAL ELECTION OFFICE, HEADED BY THE CITY OR MUNICIPAL ELECTION OFFICER WITH THE RANK OF DIRECTOR I. THERE SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) ASSISTANT ELECTION SPECIALISTS IN EVERY CITY OR MUNICIPALITY: PROVIDED, THAT FOR EVERY ADDITIONAL 20,000 VOTERS IN EXCESS OF 50,000 VOTERS, ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT ELECTION SPECIALISTS SHALL BE APPOINTED. OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE ARE

"ONLY THE PERSONNEL MENTIONED IN THIS SECTION OR EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY LAW, SHALL BE ASSIGNED, DESIGNATED, ENGAGED OR DETAILED AT THE COMMISSION'S FIELD OFFICES, OR ALLOWED TO PERFORM ADMINISTRATIVE OR CLERICAL WORK IN THE FIELD OFFICES. VIOLATION OF THIS PROVISION SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ELECTION OFFENSE.

The Commission may delegate its powers and functions or order the implementation or enforcement of its orders, rulings or decisions through the heads of its field offices.

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORGANIZATION, STAFFING,

- 5 SEC. 2. The amount necessary for the initial implementation of this Act
- 6 shall be charged against the available appropriations of the COMELEC.
- 7 Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for its continued implementation shall
- 8 be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- 9 SEC. 3. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the
- 10 Chairperson of the Commission on Elections shall, in coordination with the
- 11 Chairperson of the Civil Service Commission and Secretary of Budget and
- 12 Management, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective
- implementation of this Act.
- SEC. 4. If any provision or part of this Act is declared invalid or
- unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in
- 16 force and effect.
- SEC. 5. All laws, executive orders, issuances, decrees, rules and
- 18 regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this
- 19 Act are amended, modified, or repealed accordingly.
- SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
- 21 the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
