AN ACT

CONVERTING THE BATAAN PENINSULA STATE UNIVERSITY-BAGAC EXTENSION CAMPUS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAGAC, PROVINCE OF BATAAN, INTO A REGULAR CAMPUS OF THE BATAAN PENINSULA STATE UNIVERSITY, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "BATAAN PENINSULA STATE UNIVERSITY-BAGAC CAMPUS", AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Bataan Peninsula State University-
2 Bagac Campus Act".
3

4 SEC. 2. The Bagac Extension Campus of the Bataan Peninsula State University
5 (BPSU) located in the Municipality of Bagac, Province of Bataan, is hereby converted into a
6 regular campus, to be known as the BPSU-Bagac Campus.
7

8 SEC. 3. The BPSU-Bagac Campus shall primarily provide short-term, technical-
9 vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within its areas of competency and
10 specialization, pursuant to the mandate of the BPSU, and according to its capability, as the
11 Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem necessary to respond to
12 the human resource development needs of the Province of Bataan and Region III. It is also
13 mandated to undertake research and extension services, and to provide progressive
14 leadership in these areas
15

16 SEC. 4. The BPSU-Bagac Campus shall be headed by a Campus Administrator who
17 shall be appointed by the Board, subject to its guidelines on qualifications and standards,
18 and based on the recommendation of a search committee duly constituted for the purpose of
19 selecting the Campus Administrator.

21 SEC. 5. The BPSU shall ensure that the minimum requirements of the Commission on
22 Higher Education (CHED) for the operation of the BPSU-Bagac Campus, including those
23 related to its course offerings, are fully complied with.

1 SEC. 6. All assets, both real and personal, personnel, and records of the BPSU-Bagac
2 Campus, as well as its liabilities or obligations, shall be titled under or named after the
3 BPSU.
4

5 All parcels of land belonging to the government to be occupied by the BPSU-Bagac
6 Campus shall be the property of the BPSU, and shall be titled under its name: *Provided*,
7 That should the campus cease to exist or be abolished or should such aforementioned
8 parcels of land be no longer needed by the BPSU, the same shall revert to the concerned
9 local government unit or to the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.
10

11 SEC. 7. The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher
12 Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form part of this Act.
13

14 SEC. 8. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included
15 in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).
16

17 The Municipality of Bagac shall provide the same assistance until such time that the
18 amount necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the BPSU-Bagac Campus
19 shall be included in the annual GAA.
20

21 SEC. 9. Within sixty (60) days after the effectivity of this Act, the Board shall, in
22 consultation with the CHED, issue the rules and regulations to fully implement the
23 provisions of this Act.
24

25 SEC. 10. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
26 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and
27 effect.

29 SEC. 11. All other laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations
30 contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or modified
31 accordingly.

33 SEC. 12. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
34 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
