### AN ACT

RATIONALIZING THE DISABILITY PENSION OF VETERANS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6948, ENTITLED, "AN ACT STANDARDIZING AND UPGRADING THE BENEFITS FOR MILITARY VETERANS AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES," AS AMENDED

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This legislation-proposes to address the pressing need for our veterans and their beneficiaries, who have been disabled due to sickness, disease, wounds, or injuries sustained in the line of duty, to increase and rationalize the disability pension rates.

The State, in recognizing the sacrifices and patriotic services of our veterans for the cause of freedom and democracy and maintenance of peace and order, should continue fulfilling its constitutional mandate to "provide immediate and adequate care, benefits, and other forms of assistance to war veterans and veterans of military campaigns and their surviving spouses" (Sec. 7, Article XVI of the 1987 Constitution) and beneficiaries.



It is the intention of this measure to support our veterans by increasing the disability pension to cover, among others, medical and hospitalization expenses, the economic and social ramifications of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the increase in the prices of oil, food, and other consumer goods.

In this light, the immediate passage of this bill is highly recommended.


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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 5 of Republic Act No. 6948, as amended, is hereby further 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "Sec. 5. 32	reaching the age of seventy (70) is deemed totally disabled

1	[with one-hundred per-centum (190%) rating] and shall be
2	entitled to a monthly pension of One thousand seven hundred
3	pesos (PI,700.00) ONLY; [plus Five hundred pesos (P500.00)
4	for the spouse and each unmarried minor children.]
5	PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT THE ENTITLEMENT TO
6	THE DISABILITY PENSION AUTHORIZED HEREIN
7	SHALL BE PROSPECTIVE AND LIMITED TO ELIGIBLE
8	LIVING VETERANS ONLY."

- Sec. 2. *Appropriations.* The initial amount necessary for the implementation of this Act shall be charged against the current year's available appropriations of the Philippine Veterans Office. Thereafter, such sums as may be needed for the continued implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- Sec. 3. *Separability Clause*. If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provision or part not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.
- Sec. 4. *Repealing Clause.* Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule, or regulation contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.
- Sec. 5. *Effectivity.* This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
