

SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REFORM ACT OF 2015"


EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Sangguniang Kabataan has provided the youth with the avenue for participation in various levels of local government, particularly in local legislation and implementation of programs and projects.

However, no national organization was created under Republic Act No. 10742, or the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 that will further strengthen the Sangguniang Kabataan's vital role in nation building and that will promote more efficient and effective networking and consensus-building among its members, particularly in addressing issues on governance and project implementation.

Accordingly, this bill seeks to organize a national federation for the Sangguniang Kabataan, and to provide for the membership of the elected President to the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

PRESIDENT IN THE UNION OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES OF THE
PHILIPPINES, AMENDING FOR THIS PURPOSE SECTIONS 21 AND 22
OF PUBLIC ACT NO. 10742, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REFORM ACT OF 2015"

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21 of Republic Act No. 10742 or the "Sangguniang
2 Kabataan Reform Act of 2015" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 "SEC. 21. *Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan.* – (a) There shall
4 be an organization of the Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang
5 Kabataan to be known as follows:
6 (1) In municipalities, Pambayang Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang
7 Kabataan which shall be composed of the Sangguniang Kabataan
8 chairpersons of barangays in the municipality;
9 (2) In cities, the Panlungsod na Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang
10 Kabataan which shall be composed of the Sangguniang Kabataan
11 chairpersons of barangays in the city; **[and]**

1 (3) In provinces, Panlalawigang Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang
2 Kabataan which shall be composed of the convenors of the
3 Pambayan and Panlungsod na Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang
4 Kabataan[.]; **AND**

5 **(4) AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL, NASYONAL NA PEDERASYON NG**
6 **MGA SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN WHICH SHALL BE COMPOSED**
7 **OF THE ELECTED PRESIDENTS OF THE PANLALAWIGANG**
8 **PEDERASYON NG MGA SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN. XXX XXX**
9 **XXX”**

10 SEC. 2. Section 22 of Republic Act No. 10742 is hereby amended to read
11 as follows:

12 “SEC. 22. *Membership in the Sanggunian and Local Special Bodies.*
13 – (a) The duly elected president of the Pederasyon ng Sangguniang
14 Kabataan, at all levels, shall serve as *ex officio* member of the
15 Sangguniang Bayan, Sangguniang Panlungsod, **[and]** Sangguniang
16 Panlalawigan **AND THE UNION OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES OF**
17 **THE PHILIPPINES**, respectively; **XXX XXX XXX”**

19 SEC. 3. *Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).* – The National Youth
20 Commission, the DILG, and the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines,
21 in consultation with the local government leagues, and various youth
22 organizations and youth-serving organizations shall be tasked to come up,
23 within sixty (60) days upon approval of this Act, with the IRR needed for the
24 implementation of this Act.

25 SEC. 4. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or
26 provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts
27 or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

1 SEC. 5. *Repealing Clause.* – All other laws, presidential decrees,
2 executive orders letters of instruction, rules and regulations or portions
3 thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified
4 accordingly.

6 SEC. 6. *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
7 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
