


AN ACT
SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF ILEB, NEW COLAYO VILLAGE,
KINAMA AND NAMBARAN DAYA FROM BARANGAY NAMBARAN, CITY
OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A
SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS
BARANGAY NAMBARAN EAST

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Barangay Nambaran is one of the largest of the forty-three (43) barangays of the City of Tabuk in the Province of Kalinga. The four sitios of Ileb, Kinama, New Colayo Village and Nambaran Daya are populated by the Sumadel, Butbut, Bangad and Tulgao, all belonging to the Tinglayan-Kalinga tribes and natives from Colayo of the Pasil-Kalinga tribe. Due to their proximity to one another and their distance from the barangay's center, these four sitios are always given the least priority for development projects and the provision of essential services. The people who live in these four sitios feel that the government have ignored and disregarded them.

Hence, this measure seeks to separate the sitios of Ileb, New Colayo Village, Kinama and Nambaran Daya from their mother barangay, Barangay Nambaran of the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga, to be known as Barangay Nambaran East. With this, it is hoped that the newly established Barangay Nambaran East won't be hindered by a lack of resources, allowing them to set their own goals for socioeconomic growth.

For the abovementioned reasons, the passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF ILEB, NEW COLAYO VILLAGE,
KINAMA AND NAMBARAN DAYA FROM BARANGAY NAMBARAN, CITY
OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A
SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS
BARANGAY NAMBARAN EAST

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** *Creation of Barangay Nambaran East.* – The sitios of Ileb, New
2 Colayo Village, Kinama and Nambaran Daya are hereby separated from Barangay
3 Nambaran in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a separate and
4 independent barangay to be known as Barangay Nambaran East.

5
6 **SEC. 2.** *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of Barangay
7 Nambaran East shall be described as follows:

9 " Bounded on the East by the Municipality of Rizal; on the South by Barangay
10 Lacnog; on the West by Barangay Nambaran; and on the Northwest by Barangay
11 Dilag."

13 **SEC. 3.** *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – Pursuant to Section 10 of
14 Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the " Local Government Code of 1991" ,
15 the new Barangay Nambaran East shall exist upon the approval by a majority of the
16 votes cast by the qualified voters of Barangay Nambaran in a plebiscite to be conducted
17 and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in the area affected, not
18 later than one hundred twenty (120) days from the effectivity of this Act.

1 The amount necessary for the conduct of such plebiscite shall be borne by the
2 City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga.

3
4 **SEC. 4. *Barangay Officials.*** – The first set of officials of Barangay Nambaran
5 East shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor and shall hold office until such time
6 that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

7
8 **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.*** – All public infrastructure and
9 facilities existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby transferred
10 without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new barangay.

11
12 **SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay Nambaran East shall be
13 entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of the
14 Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.

15
16 **SEC. 7. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
17 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
