

APPOINTMENT OF CONFERENCE

Senator TOLENTINO. With conference to the conference sought by the House on H. B. No. 3565 regarding a study of the financing of public schools, I move that we accept the invitation to a conference and appoint Senators Roy, Osias and Puyat as our members of the conference committee.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, with respect to the request of the House for conference regarding H. B. No. 11773 on additional fiscal in La Union, I move that we accept the request for conference and appoint Senators Diokno, Tañada and Padilla as our members for the conference committee.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the motion is carried and the conference committee is so constituted.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, there are two bills, H. B. No. 16961 and H. B. No. 16361, one of which has been referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources and the other to the Committee on Commerce and Industry. With the consent of the distinguished chairman of said committees, I move that these two bills be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the motion is carried and the two bills, H. No.

16961 and H. No. 16361, are referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

RECONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL  
OF H. B. NO. 3018

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, the Senate had already approved finally on third reading H. B. 30. 3018 containing amendments to the Medical Act of 1959. Because of some amendments which were found necessary to be introduced, with the unanimous consent of the House, I move that we reconsider both second and third readings of this bill.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the motion is carried and approval of H. B. 3018 is reconsidered.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, since we are on this bill already I move that we consider it now to introduce amendments.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the motion is carried and we are now in the period of amendments.

Senator TOLENTINO. The amendments sought to be introduced are the following: On page 2, line 18, after "MONTH," insert the following: "EXCEPT OFFICIALS RECEIVING REGULAR SALARIES FROM THE GOVERNMENT,"

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the amendment is approved.

Senator TOLENTINO. On page 3 and 12, delete the words "DETERMINE AND PRESCRIBE" and in lieu thereof insert "RECOMMEND".

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the amendment is approved.

Senator TOLENTINO. On page 4, line 24, delete the words "Twenty-four" and in lieu thereof insert the words "AS MANY" and on page 5, line 1, delete the words "pursuant to Republic Act Numbered Eighteen hundred and eighty-one" to line 2 and in lieu thereof insert "AS MAY BE PROVIDED BY LAW".

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the amendment is approved.

Senator TOLENTINO. On page 12, line 23, delete the brackets before and after the line.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) There being none, the amendment is approved.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, as amended I move that the bill be approved on second reading.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. The chamber will now vote on second reading. As many as are in favor of the bill will please say *Aye*. (Several senators said *Aye*.) As many as are against will please say *Nay*. (*Silence.*) The bill is approved on second reading as amended.

#### RESUMPTION OF CONSIDERATION H. B. NO. 5862

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, I move that we resume consideration of H. B. No. 5862.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Resumption of the consideration of House Bill No. 5862 is now in order.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, when we suspended consideration of this bill we were in the period of amendments, and the question came up with respect to the name of Rajah Buayan raised by the distinguished gentleman from La Union.

Senator OSIAS. Mr. President.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. What is the pleasure of the gentleman from La Union?

Senator OSIAS. Mr. President, I think I am partly responsible for the Senate not voting on the Bill at the time when it was presented for consideration. It was not because I was opposed to the bill, but I wanted to get some information with respect to the change of the name and the new name proposed. I have received intelligence through inquiries, Mr. President, that Rajah Buayan is the founder of that community in the fourteenth century, and our brethren in the southland, especially the Muslims, desire to immortalize one who has performed some historical deeds, and so I am withdrawing my opposition and I am gladly in favor of the passage of this bill.

Senator TOLENTINO. Mr. President, of that manifestation I ask that we go to the period of amendments.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. We are in the period of amendments.

Senator TOLENTINO. There is attached to the report of the committee, Mr. President, a list of committee amendments. There are some imperfections and some typographical errors. I move that these committee amendments be approved, Mr. President.

The PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) The Chairs hears none. The committee amendments are approved.
