

INTRODUCED BY THE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC WORKS

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR PUBLIC
WORKS, SYNCHRONIZING THE SAME WITH
PREVIOUS PUBLIC WORKS APPROPRIATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Capital Improvements from General Fund.*—
2 For the implementation of public works projects which
3 are included in the 1962-1963 phase of a Long Range
4 Program of Capital Improvements of the administration,
5 the following sums or so much thereof as may be neces-
6 sary are hereby appropriated out of the general funds
7 in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, sub-
8 ject to the provisions hereinafter set forth, for the purposes
9 mentioned hereunder:

10 TITLE A.—BUILDINGS

11 a. For the completion, construction, re-
12 construction, improvement, addition and/or
13 alteration of national buildings including the
14 purchase of necessary construction materials

7 by contract thru public biddings with opera-
8 tors of private sawmills or lumber yards in
9 any Congressional District of the Philip-
10 pines, where the capacity of such sawmills
11 or lumber yards is adequate to handle con-
12 tracts amounting to not more than ₱20,000
13 at one time; *Provided, further*, That only
14 unmanufactured articles, materials, or sup-
15 plies of the growth or production of the
16 Philippines and only such manufactured
17 articles, materials and supplies as have been
18 manufactured in the Philippines substan-
19 tially from articles, materials or supplies of
20 the growth, production or manufacture of
21 the Philippines of proven quality shall be
22 purchased; *Provided, finally*, That the school
23 room units so produced shall be allocated
24 in accordance with and without exception
25 to the proportion established in Republic
26 Act Numbered 836, as amended ₱5,000,000.00

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

11 SEC. 5. *Program of Work Required Before Prosecuting*
12 *Public Works.*—Before prosecuting any public works proj-
13 ect, the district, city or project engineer concerned shall
14 prepare a program of work for approval by the Depart-
15 ment Head concerned for projects with an estimated cost
16 of more than P100,000, by the Bureau Head concerned for
17 projects with an estimated cost of more than P50,000 but
18 not exceeding P100,000, by the Division Engineer concerned
19 for projects with an estimated cost of more than P25,000
20 but not exceeding P50,000, and by the District or City Engi-
21 neer concerned for projects with an estimated cost of
22 P25,000 or less, and in no case shall construction work on a
23 project be started before the program of work has been ap-
24 proved. No program of work for any project which re-
25 quires special site investigation, survey and construction
26 plans shall be approved unless such plans are used as basis

1 of the program. For any project already being undertaken,
 2 the Engineer concerned may be allowed to submit a revised
 3 program of work before the completion of the project, if,
 4 due to unforeseen contingencies or to changes in field con-
 5 ditions or other similar circumstances, it becomes evident
 6 that he cannot successfully accomplish the work within his
 7 original program. The Auditor General or his authorized
 8 representatives shall be furnished a copy of the program of
 9 work for his guidance and shall have access to the data
 10 on which the program was based.

11 SEC. 6. *Rental of Equipment.*—Rental of equipment shall
 12 not be deducted at the time of the release of funds for
 13 public works or even in anticipation of use of the equip-
 14 ment but shall be paid based on actual use when the ap-
 15 propriation so released is ₱20,000 or less. When the ap-
 16 propriation so released is above ₱20,000, and use of rented
 17 equipment is anticipated then deduction for rental shall be
 18 made at the time of the release of funds but such deduc-

21 SEC. 7. *Prohibition in the Use of Sums Appropriated*
 22 *Herein.*—No appropriation herein authorized shall be used
 23 for the purchase of office equipment and supplies, automo-
 24 biles or station wagons, nor be used to pay salaries or
 25 wages of employees not directly engaged in the work or
 26 assigned officially to, projects for which the appropriation
 27 has been made, nor be used as aid for calamities.

1 SEC. 8. *Suspension of Work Done by Administration*
 2 *Before General Elections.*—The provisions of any existing
 3 law to the contrary notwithstanding, regardless of the
 4 source of funds, within forty-five days before every general
 5 or special election, no laborer shall be employed in, or
 6 money spent for, any public works projects even if the
 7 appropriation is actually released before or within such
 8 period except for:

9 (a) Ordinary maintenance of existing and/or completed
 10 public works projects; *Provided*, That not more than the
 11 number of usual laborers or employees already employed
 12 therein sixty days prior to the beginning of the forty-five
 13 day period shall be permitted to work during such time;
 14 *Provided, further*, That no extra gang of laborers shall
 15 be employed within the said period of forty-five days;

16 (b) Work undertaken by contract through public bidding
 17 held, or by negotiated contract awarded, before the forty-
 18 five day period; *Provided*, That work for the purpose of
 19 this section undertaken under the so-called "Takay" or
 20 "paquiao" system shall not be considered as work by
 21 contract;

22 (c) Payment for the usual cost of preparation of working
 23 drawings, specifications, bills of materials, estimates, and
 24 other procedures preparatory to actual construction includ-
 25 ing the purchase of materials and equipment, and all in-
 26 cidental expenses for wages of watchmen and other laborers:

1 employed for such work in the central offices and field
2 storehouses before the beginning of such period; *Provided*,
3 That the number of such laborers shall not be increased
4 over the number hired when the project or projects were
5 commenced;

6 (d) Emergency work necessitated by the occurrence of
7 a public calamity, but such work shall be limited to the
8 restoration of the damaged facility.

9 No payment should be made five days before the date
10 of election to laborers who rendered service in projects
11 that were overdraft at the time the work was rendered,
12 except those laborers falling under subsections *a*, *b*, *c*, and
13 *d* of this section.

14 Any violation of the foregoing provisions shall constitute
15 a serious offense punishable under the provisions of the
16 Revised Election Code.

17 SEC. 9. *Payment of Labor and Readjustment of Con-*
18 *tracts.*—All contracts for the furnishing of materials or
19 supplies and for the construction of any project authorized
20 in this Act, executed by any person, association or cor-
21 poration with the government after the approval of this
22 Act shall contain provisions adequately covering the prose-
23 cution of the following:

24 (a) The contractor shall provide and have on hand every
25 pay-day, in addition to the usual requirement of cash out-
26 lay for the contract work, a labor fund in an amount
27 sufficient to cover each fifteen-day labor payroll for the

1 project and payment to the laborers and employees shall
2 be made within three days after every pay-period. Pay-
3 ment of wages and salaries to laborers and employees
4 engaged in the project shall be witnessed by the engineer-
5 in-charge of the work or his representative, who shall
6 certify to such payment. Upon failure of the contractor
7 to pay his laborers and employees within the period herein
8 stated, the Government shall forthwith make such payment
9 out of the funds of the project, in which case the sum
10 paid out plus a surcharge of one per cent shall be deducted
11 from any amount due or to become due the contractor
12 without prejudice to the right of the Government to rescind
13 the contract;

14 (b) Should the Government, at any time during the
15 effectivity of a contract, impose, abolish, modify any tax,
16 customs duties, license, impost, fee or other similar charges,
17 or enact, amend or repeal any law affecting the number of
18 hours of labor permissible a day or the number of days
19 a week or the wages or salaries to be paid to laborers
20 and employees, which would directly increase or decrease
21 the cost of materials or the cost of the construction work
22 beyond or under the amount stipulated in the contract, the
23 contract amount shall be readjusted accordingly by a com-
24 mittee, hereby created for this purpose, composed of the
25 Auditor-General as Chairman, the Secretary of Public
26 Works and Communications and the Commissioner of the

1 Budget as members; *Provided*, That the party seeking
 2 adjustment shall first apply for same in writing, stating
 3 therein the reasons justifying the change as well as the
 4 data and computations in sufficient detail which would
 5 determine accurately the amount of the change.

6 SEC. 10. *Use of Excess Funds.*—Whenever any of the
 7 short-term project is completed and a balance of appro-
 8 priation remains, the district or city engineer may use
 9 such balance for the purchase or acquisition of essential
 10 equipment or for any urgent improvement work pertaining
 11 to the project, or for covering deficiency of appropriation
 12 of any project of the same category within the same munic-
 13 ipality.

14 SEC. 11. *Prosecution by Civic Organizations, Barrio*
 15 *Councils, and Parent-Teachers Associations of Rural Pro-*
 16 *gress Projects.*—Whenever the appropriation amounting to
 17 not more than fifteen thousand pesos, for any project au-
 18 thorized in this Act and previous Public Works Acts which
 19 does not require complicated methods of constructions nor
 20 highly specialized techniques, is released or made available
 21 for expenditure, wholly or partly, such project may be
 22 undertaken by administration without the necessity of secur-
 23 ing the previous authority from the Office of the President.

24 The work shall then be prosecuted by the Barrio Council,
 25 or the most concerned Civil Organization or the Parent-
 26 Teacher Association in the case of school building project,

1 or by direct administration of the District or City Engineer,
 2 whichever is the most advantageous to the project as may
 3 be determined by the District or City Engineer in the
 4 manner herein provided.

5 The application for undertaking such work shall be filed
 6 by the organization concerned with the District or City
 7 Engineer or his official counterpart, as the case may be,
 8 specifying, among other things, the barrio-management
 9 program of work, or the payment to be received for the
 10 work. After evaluating the offers and the terms proposed
 11 by the Barrio Council or the Civic Organization or Parent-
 12 Teacher Association, as the case may be, by comparing
 13 them with the corresponding approved program of work
 14 and estimate, the work on the project may be turned over
 15 to the Barrio Council for prosecution or awarded to the
 16 applicant Civic Organization or Parent-Teacher Association
 17 through a negotiated contract for an amount not to exceed
 18 ninety percent of the cost of the work as originally estimated
 19 and programmed pursuant to Section five of this Act.

20 Under no circumstance shall the provisions of this sec-
 21 tion be construed to deprive the District or City Engineer
 22 or his official counterpart, as the case may be, of his super-
 23 visory control over any of the projects referred to in this
 24 section nor to relieve him of any responsibility, adminis-
 25 trative or otherwise, for any defect in procedure, control
 26 or technical surveillance, resulting in waste of money,

1 destruction of or damage to property, or lowering of en-
 2 gineering standards. In cases where the work is pro-
 3 secuted by administration of the Barrio Council or through
 4 negotiated contract with a Civic Organization, the District
 5 or City Engineer, or his representative shall not charge
 6 against the fund of the project any expense for inspection
 7 by him or his assistant but he may designate as his re-
 8 presentative and assign to the project as worker-inspector
 9 any competent craftsman whose compensation and travel
 10 expenses for the duration of the assignment shall be
 11 chargeable against the funds of the project but not against
 12 the contract and shall not exceed two percent of the
 13 contract price. The District or City Engineer, or his
 14 official counterpart, may make any other suitable arrange-
 15 ment to enable him to maintain supervisory control over
 16 the project without, however, exceeding the compensation
 17 limitation herein imposed.

18 The provisions of existing laws to the contrary not-
 19 withstanding, the Civic Organization, Parent-Teacher As-
 20 sociation or Barrio Council undertaking any work under
 21 this section shall be exempt from any kind of performance
 22 bond, and from all taxes and imposts relating thereto.

23 *SEC. 12. Preference to Local Labor.*—In the execution
 24 and construction of projects authorized in this and prev-
 25 ious Public Works Acts, especially of Rural Progress
 26 projects and of school building projects, the labor require-

1 ments shall be filled by laborers from the place or munic-
 2 ipality where the project is being undertaken, however,
 3 in case of skilled labor, it may be procured elsewhere
 4 within the province where the project is located only after
 5 the Mayor of the municipality where the project is located
 6 certifies that no skilled labor is available in his locality;
 7 such certificate to be part of the time book and payroll
 8 for that project. Any violation of this provision will be
 9 sufficient cause for the relief of the District Engineer
 10 concerned and such disciplinary action by the Secretary
 11 of Public Works and Communications.

12 *SEC. 13. Use of Private Consulting Services.*—For any
 13 public works project authorized in this Act and previous
 14 Public Works Acts with an estimated cost of P200,000 or
 15 more, the Secretary of Public Works and Communications
 16 may hire the services of local consultants or consulting
 17 firms, for a fee not exceeding four and one half per centum
 18 of the estimated cost, to review the project report or plans
 19 and specifications devised by the bureau or office concerned,
 20 or to prepare the project report including plans and spe-
 21 cifications thereof. For purposes of this section, the head
 22 of Bureau or Agency concerned, with the approval of the
 23 Secretary of Public Works and Communications, shall
 24 formulate guiding principles to be used as a basis of
 25 setting up fees or rates for various types of consulting
 26 work.

1 SEC. 14. *Publication of Call for Bids in Local News-*
 2 *papers.*—Any law, rule or regulation to the contrary not-
 3 withstanding, in the calling for bids as required by law
 4 for the execution of any public works project, advertise-
 5 ment thereof in any newspaper of general circulation in
 6 Manila and/or the locality, or province, or region where
 7 the project is located is sufficient compliance to the per-
 8 tinent provisions of the Revised Administrative Code.

9 SEC. 15. *Purchase of Sites.*—Any appropriation herein
 10 authorized for construction of any schoolhouse project shall
 11 be understood to cover the acquisition or purchase of sites
 12 whenever such acquisition or purchase is necessary for
 13 the prosecution of the project; *Provided*, That the price
 14 to be paid from such appropriation shall not exceed the
 15 assessed value thereof.

16 SEC. 16. *Hydroelectric Installations.*—The appropri-
 17 ations authorized in this Act as well as in previous Public
 18 Works Acts for irrigation and river control projects shall
 19 be understood to include outlays for hydro-electric installa-
 20 tions in such projects whenever the hydraulic drop thereof
 21 is sufficient to generate appreciable hydroelectric energy;
 22 *Provided*, That the hydro-electric plant shall be operated
 23 by the Director of Public Works as part of the project
 24 and the income thereof constituted into a special fund
 25 for the amortization of costs of construction of the said
 26 projects.

1 SEC. 17. *Purchase of Materials, Equipment and Sup-*
 2 *plies.*—The provisions of existing laws, executive orders,
 3 rules and regulations to the contrary notwithstanding, the
 4 department head concerned is authorized, in the interest
 5 of public service, subject to auditing requirements, to
 6 procure the necessary materials, equipment and supplies
 7 needed for the construction, reconstruction, improvement,
 8 repair and/or maintenance of any public works project as
 9 provided in this and previous Public Works Acts, regardless
 10 of the source of funds; *Provided*, That when materials and
 11 supplies are obtainable locally in the district, city or
 12 neighboring district the same may be procured by the
 13 district or city engineer without prior authority from the
 14 department head; *Provided, further*, That the Secretary of
 15 Public Works and Communications and the Auditor Gen-
 16 eral may promulgate rules and regulations to implement
 17 this provision; *Provided, finally*, That no surcharge shall
 18 be imposed for the service of procuring such materials,
 19 supplies and equipments.

20 SEC. 18. *Engineering Surcharge.*—Any provision of law,
 21 executive order, rule or regulation to the contrary not-
 22 withstanding, and regardless of the source of funds, no
 23 national surcharge shall be collected from the appropria-
 24 tions or expenditures authorized for any category of public
 25 works, and provincial surcharge on expenditures of ap-
 26 propriations for any public works project shall not exceed
 27 four per cent.

1 SEC. 19. *Public Works Appropriations Under This Act*
 2 *Are National Disbursing Funds: Exceptions.*—Any provi-
 3 sion of existing law to the contrary notwithstanding, all
 4 funds appropriated under the provisions of this Act shall,
 5 when released, be carried in the account books of the
 6 treasurers as national disbursing funds and all projects
 7 herein specified are classified as national projects unless
 8 such funds are appropriated specifically as aid to the
 9 province, chartered city or municipality, as the case may
 10 be, in which case such funds shall be disbursed as local
 11 funds; *Provided*, That provincial fund allocated as coun-
 12 ter-part shall not be considered as national fund.

13 SEC. 20. *Interchangeability of Financing Methods.*—Sub-
 14 ject to the provisions of Republic Act Numbered One
 15 Thousand, as amended, upon recommendation of the Sec-
 16 retary of Public Works and Communications and the
 17 National Economic Council, the President of the Philip-
 18 pines is authorized to modify the financing methods in-
 19 dicated in this and previous Public Works Acts, so as to
 20 enable the department head concerned to undertake pro-
 21 jects financed from general revenue with the proceeds from
 22 the sale of bonds and/or loans, or vice versa.

23 SEC. 21. *Reports.*—Before the opening day of every reg-
 24 ular session of Congress, the Department Head concerned
 25 shall submit an accomplishment report to both Houses of
 26 Congress and to the President. Such report shall be in

1 printed and bound form, and shall include the appro-
 2 priations released as of date of said report and the percent-
 3 age of work accomplished, further work to be done to
 4 complete the program of broad categories of public works,
 5 and his recommendation, if any, for transfer of appro-
 6 priations or for program changes to be incorporated in
 7 the next Public Works Appropriation Act.

8 SEC. 22. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
